

- La expresión **there is** (singular) pasa a ser **there are** en plural.  
Ejemplo: **There is** a hole in your pocket.  
**There are** many nice flowers in that garden.
- En la **forma interrogativa**, **there** se coloca **después** del verbo.  
Ejemplo: **Is there** a problem?  
**Are there** lots of children on the playground?
- En la **forma negativa**, **there is** pasa a ser **there isn't** (there is not) y **there are** pasa a ser **there aren't** (there are not).  
Ejemplo: **There isn't** any milk left.  
**There aren't** many mistakes in your paper.
