

The **indirect interrogatives** are made up of:

- a **principal clause** with an **interrogative verb** such as **to ask, to wonder** or **to discuss...**
- a **subordinate clause** introduced by an **interrogative term** (if, whether, where, when, why, how, who, which, what or whose).

The verb of the subordinate clause is placed **after the subject**, as with non-interrogative sentences.

*Example:*

We **discussed what** kind of present we **could** offer her.
