The **indirect interrogatives** are made up of:

- a principal clause with an interrogative verb such as to ask, to wonder or to discuss...
- a subordinate clause introduced by an interrogative term (if, whether, where, when, why, how, who, which, what or whose).

The verb of the subordinate clause is placed **after the subject**, as with non-interrogative sentences.

## Example:

We discussed what kind of present we could offer her.
