

Changing the Panorama Controls

To personalize the motion and size of your panorama, follow the instructions to [open the Display Control Panel](#) and activate the *Screensaver Configuration* dialog. Select the desired module and click the **Configure** button. This will open a dialog with configuration settings for the selected display module.

The following module is included in the SmoothMove ScreenSaver you have downloaded. Others are available through Infinite Pictures and 3rd party developers.

Pan-O-Rama

This module works with *SmoothMove Panorama* (.pan) files obtained from the Infinite Pictures web site (<http://www.smoothmove.com/>) or a variety of other sites on the web. Enter the full path for the desired .pan file in the *File to display* edit box, or click the **Browse** button and select a panorama.

1. To increase the image display size, move the **Window size** slider to the right. To decrease the size, move it to the left.
2. To increase the image turning speed, move the **Turning speed** slider to the far left or far right. To decrease the speed, move it to the center.
3. To increase the image pitching speed, move the "Pitching speed" slider to the right. To decrease the speed, move it to the left. When adjusting the pitching speed, its best to start close to the left.
4. To increase the image rolling speed, move the "Rolling speed" slider to the right. To decrease the speed, move it to the left. When adjusting rolling speed, it is best to start close to the left..
5. To increase the image view width (how far it is zoomed out), move the "Zoom level" slider to the right. To decrease the view width, move it to the left. Images usually look best if you set this close to the middle. Extremes can look pretty wild.

The turning speed, pitching speed and rolling speed can be set to randomly change speeds up to the chosen maximums by selecting or deselecting the neighboring **Random** check boxes. The *panorama view* window can be set to move around the screen or remain centered by selecting or deselecting the neighboring **Moving** check box.

To accept the configuration changes, click on the **OK** button. To cancel changes, click the **Cancel** button.

Configuring Your ScreenSaver

To configure the SmoothMove ScreenSaver, you will first have to open the **Display Properties** Control Panel:

1. Click the **Start** menu button.
2. Choose the **Settings** menu.
3. Click on the **Control Panel** item in the submenu.
4. Find the **Display** panel and double-click on it.
5. Choose the **Screen Saver** tab.

If the *SmoothMove ScreenSaver* is not already selected in the drop down list, select it now. There may be a pause as your SmoothMove ScreenSaver decompresses your images. Be patient, there is a lot of work being done behind the scenes on your computer.

Now that the **Display Properties** Control Panel is open, click the **Settings** button. The *screensaver configuration dialog* will open. It should list the pan-o-rama module included with the SmoothMove ScreenSaver. Other modules are available through Infinite Pictures web site and 3rd party developers.

The Cube-O-Rama module displays a rotating, bouncing cube with images on each face.

Modules are the various types of screensavers, such as Slide-O-Rama, Cube-o-rama or Pan-O-Rama.

The Pan-O-Rama module displays a SmoothMove Panorama, moving and rotating according to the module settings. SmoothMove Panoramas are images that show what can be seen from every possible angle.

The Slide-O-Rama module displays a sequence of images, either full size or in random locations on the screen.

Uninstalling

To remove the *SmoothMove ScreenSaver*, you will first have to open the **Add/Remove Programs** Control Panel.

1. Click the **Start** menu button.
2. Choose the **Settings** menu.
3. Click on the **Control Panel** item in the submenu.
4. Find the *Add/Remove Programs* panel and double-click on it.
5. Select the "SmoothMove(tm) ScreenSaver 1.0" line in the list box.
6. Click the **Add/Remove** button and follow the Uninstall program directions.

Pitching is how fast it looks up and down in the panorama.

Rolling describes clockwise or counter clockwise motion. For example, If you were to lay down on your left side, your point-of-view would *roll* to the left.
