



Graduates for the 21st Century: Promoting the Scottish Enhancement Themes in the Biosciences

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With some small-scale funding from the Academy Scotland Practitioners' Forum, the UK Centre for Bioscience has developed a resource pack to showcase the work of the QAA Scottish Enhancement Themes. The pack contains short summary flyers which provide an overview of each theme and highlight further relevant publications from the UK Centre for Bioscience. It aims to provide bioscience practitioners in both Scotland and beyond with a starting point to develop their understanding of learning and teaching issues and topics linked to each theme.
