




LTSN Background

Generic Centre


⇒offers expertise and information on learning and teaching issues that cross subject boundaries


• Technologies Centre and TechDis (funded by JISC)


⇒investigates and develops new technologies

A Network of 24 Subject Centres ⇒offer subject-based expertise




Teaching Development Grants


