The University of Birmingham

By motorway

From the M6

- Exit the motorway at junction 6, and join the A38 (M) towards Birmingham.
- Negotiate the inner Ring Road (Queensway) through Birmingham City Centre by following signs for the A38 and University
- Once on the A38 pass over the A4540, at which point the A38 becomes Bristol Road and single carriageway.
- After a further mile the road becomes a dual carriageway once again.
- The next right turn is then Edgbaston Park Road (see The Conference Park map)
- On arriving at the Conference Park proceed to Horton Grange (see Hornton Grange map)

From the M42 North

Exit the motorway at junction 8 to join the M6 northbound and follow the instructions above.

From the M5

- Exit the motorway at junction 4, and join the A38 tow ards Birmingham.
- Remain on the A38 for approximately 8 miles and after passing Sainsbury's Supermarket (on left), take the fourth left turn into Edgbaston Road (see The Conference Park map)
- On arriving at the Conference Park proceed to Horton Grange (see Hornton Grange map)

From the M40

- Turn south onto the M42.
- Exit at junction 1 and head north on the A38 Bristol Road.
- Remain on the A38 for approximately 8 miles and after passing Sainsbury's Supermarket (on left), take the fourth left turn into Edgbaston Road (see The Conference Park map)
- On arriving at the Conference Park proceed to Horton Grange (see Hornton Grange map)

Bv rail

The nearest mainline station is Birmingham New Street. The Conference Park is approximately 10mminutes by taxi.

By coach


There are frequent express coach services to Birmingham from London, Heathrow and Gatwick Airports and many UK cities. The long-distance coach station is in Digbeth in the City Centre.

By bus

Numbers 61, 62 and 63 travel from Corporation Street to the University, Griffin Close and Manor House. Numbers 83, 84 and 85 also stop at the Bristol Road entrances to the University, departing from Queensway before 6.15pm and from Stephenson Street after 6.15pm, whilst the number 21 departs from Colmore Row and serves the Medical School and Queen Elizabeth Hospital.


By air
