- TeamSite CMS
 - page creation without technical knowledge
 - creation of site navigational structure
 - workflow management
 - share content amongst sites
 - user admin

Applications II

- LiveSite
 - Dynamic components, e.g. news, funding, resources lists
 - Page templates maintain consistent look and feel while allowing users to customise their pages
 - WYSIWYG creation of pages with components means developers have more time for developing

Applications III


- MetaTagger
 - Automatic tagging of content
 - Allows presentation of resources by taxonomy, searching of content
- MediaBin
 - Automated image transformation
 - Integrated with TeamSite
- OpenDeploy
 - Integration with workflow, version control, deploy pages to web servers, data to SQL database


