

Key Objectives

- Provide an effective means for staff supporting HE in FECs to engage with the wider support infrastructure.
- To share access to HE information and resources.



Key Objectives

- To share good practice and work with colleges.
- To combine efforts with key partners to deliver a coherent and integrated support infrastructure to enhance HE learning and teaching policies and practice in FECs.
- To promote professional and scholarly development to increase the professional standing and recognition of all staff supporting HE in FECs.

Gather, Develop and Disseminate Effective Practice

- **Teaching and Learning Group** working on themes including innovations in T and L, assessment etc.
- Management, Leadership and Quality Group working on themes including the management of HE in FE, establishing a HE culture within a FE college, running exam boards etc.
