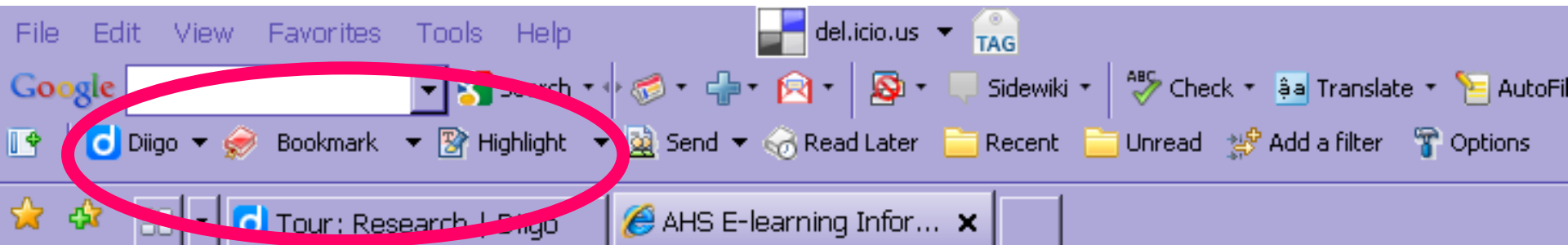

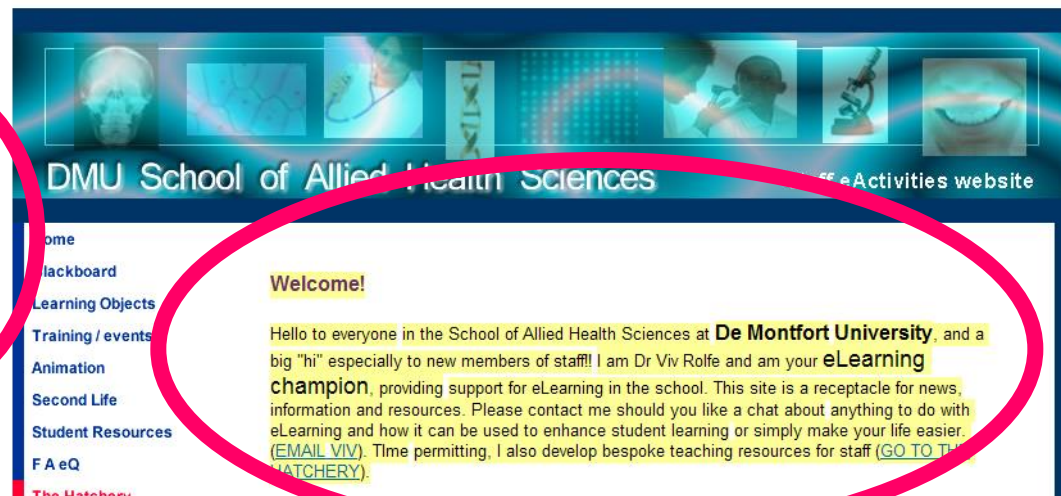
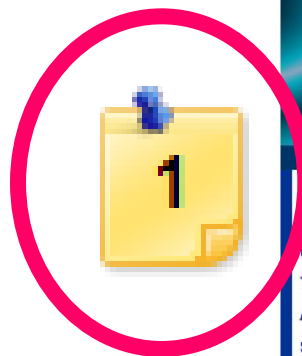

Can social book-marking enhance a systematic review process?

- ❖ Yes – can help organise web-based resources, although tagging requires some thought.
- ❖ Yes – can add notes and highlight relevant bits.
- ❖ Maybe - maximising the networking potential needs thought.
- ❖ Maybe - will be used in combination with conventional methods of writing to experts.
- ❖ Maybe – managing the growing number of **social technologies** also requires thought and a new frame of mind.
