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#### **Exercise Brief**

- Groups of 4
- Provided with a DVD of a recent TV programme on a Neuroscience topic
- Provided with a copy of the mark allocation
- 3 weeks preparation time
- Present a 15 minute critical review of the programme
- Represents 10% of the overall module mark

#### Marking

- Two main criteria
  - Content (70%)
  - Quality of the Presentation (30%)

- Evaluation of the scientific accuracy and currency of the programme (20 marks)
- Evaluation of the objectivity of the programme (20 marks)
- Evaluation of the quality of the presentation (10 marks)
- Effectiveness in targeting the audience (10 marks)

#### Marking

- Presentation
  - Clarity of the presentation (10 marks)
  - Quality of the delivery (10 marks)
  - Quality of the visual aids and their useage (10 marks)
