Science Learning & Teaching Conference Tuesday 19th – Wednesday 20th June

The conference which you are attending is at Keele University. To follow you will find some useful information about the campus and the conference you are attending.

Arrival Point / Registration

Main conference registration will take place at the medical school between 10.00 – 10.30 Tuesday 19th June. Bedroom keys can also be collected from the Medical School also at these times. After 12.00 bedrooms keys will be available from 24 hour reception Darwin Building.

Parking

We recommend that when you arrive you park at the Medical School car park or the car parks at Barnes halls of residence. Bespoke parking permits are included with this information and will also be available when you arrive at registration. These must be completed and displayed for the duration of your stay on the University campus. Please note that a wheel-clamping scheme is in operation for any unauthorised parking.

Accommodation

You will be staying at Barnes halls of residence bedrooms can be accessed after 15.00 on Tuesday 19th June. All Bedrooms are single study rooms with ensuite facilities. All bedrooms have tea and coffee making facilities and a telephone which operates via a key-com card system. These cards can be purchased from either Chancellors Building or Darwin Reception's and will be required to also receive incoming telephone calls. Please note bedrooms do not have hairdryers, TV's or alarm clocks. On the day of departure bedrooms must be vacated by 09.30. Luggage can be stored if required at the Medical School. Keys are to be deposited on departure in key return boxes which will be located in both the halls of residences reception areas and breakfast restaurants.

Main meeting area locations

All conference sessions will be based at the Medical School. The poster displays will also be based in this Medical School.

Catering areas

Refreshments during the day will be served at the Medical School.

Complimentary Use of Leisure Centre
