Meeting Aims

Entrepreneurship – a workshop for postgraduate students

This interactive workshop, led by Kevin Byron, is designed to provide participants with a 'Hands-on' experience of some of the skills required to help in the development of an Entrepreneurial spirit.

In its modern usage Entrepreneurship is more akin to an attitude change than it is about setting up a business. However, this more generic definition is best exercised and understood through seeing it in the framework of creating a new business where many of the transferable skills of Entrepreneurship can be exercised. If there is any trick to forging a successful career then adopting an entrepreneurial attitude in one's own profession is it.

Participants will work in small teams. Each team will aim to form a business, create a product and write a business plan. The day will end with an exhibition allowing the teams to demonstrate their ideas.

Kevin Byron, who is running the workshop, is an Associate of the HEA Physical Sciences Centre. He works as a consultant delivering sessions on creative problem solving and entrepreneurship to industry and academia.
