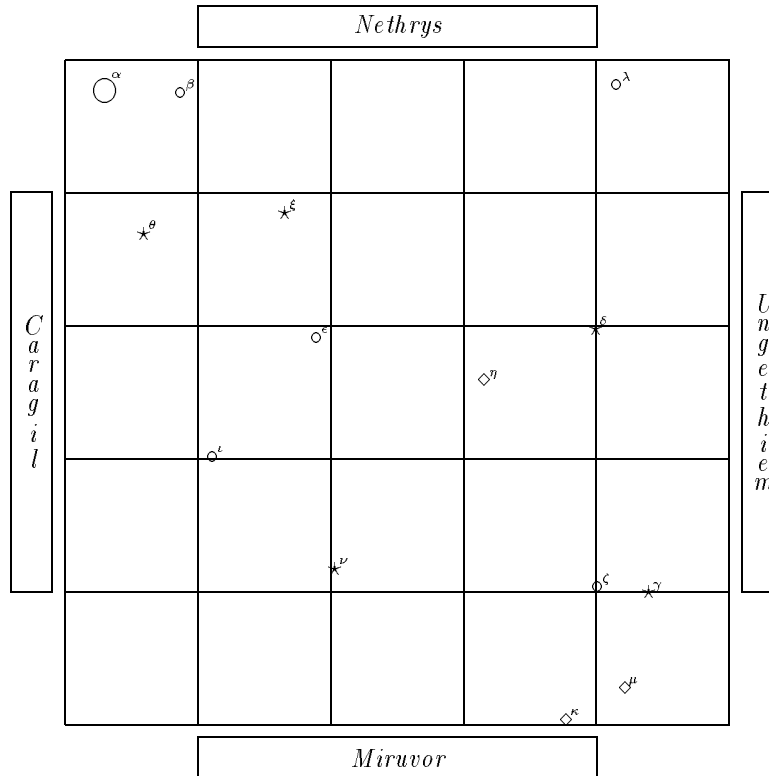

Ithilien Sector

The Ithilien sector was the site of some of the worst fighting during both the Romulan war and later during the four-years war. Oddly enough, it was perhaps because of this fighting that the worlds of this region are so heavily colonized. It is felt that future war can be averted by keeping this region strong and populated.

- (α) **Alpha Ithilia:** Named from ancient Orion myth, Ithilien was a minor goddess who stole the light of the sun as it lay down to rest, and then danced across the sky all night, only to be caught come morning. In their version of astrology, this star represents her. Historical records indicate that it pulsates violently once every several centuries.
- (γ) **Gamma Ithilia:** Also known as Kiefer, this system is owned by InterSystems Extraction, Inc. The company keeps a mining base on the system's sole planet, Iovine, which has only one continent, the vast majority of which is covered by windswept silicates.
- (δ) **Delta Ithilia:** Known locally as Kajzer, this system contains a Class-M planet with a wide assortment of organisms seemingly native to Earth's Jurassic and Cretaceous periods. A biological research station is studying the phenomenon.
- (η) **Eta Ithilia:** This system is entirely featureless except for one important exception. It is the home of Star-Base 10, one of the oldest and most prestigious starbases in Federation Space. SB10 relies on its subsidiary, Albuquerque Station, for most of the refueling operations and the maintenance of the Loknar patrol frigates which march the borders, staying to itself, instead, as a somewhat mysterious and heavily fortified defense outpost. It plays a key role in the monitoring of the borders via a complex network of cloaked, unmanned, observation pods which relay information back to the starbase via omegaon transponder nodes.
- (θ) **Theta Ithilia:** This system is wholly owned by Howard Carwile, the eccentric multi-billionaire and chairman of Rashile Gourmet Foods, Inc. Kept in pristine condition due to a massive terraforming effort, the principle planet, Carwile's World, serves as a colony and place of retirement for prominent artists throughout the Federation and beyond.
- (κ) **Kappa Ithilia:** Although the principle world of this system, Nicolii, is essentially barren, the planet serves as the site of a dilithium cracking station. It is owned and operated by Star Fleet.
- (μ) **Mu Ithilia:** Although entirely devoid of inhabitable worlds, this system contains a deep space refueling facility named Albuquerque Station. Though owned and operated by Star Fleet, it also serves non-fleet vessels.
- (ν) **Nu Ithilia:** An independent colony, this system contains a water-world known as Derigo. The inhabitants, humans and tellarites, conduct agriculture in great underwater farms, selling the bulk of their produce to Gourmet Foods, Inc., which they are largely dependent upon. Gourmet Foods has repeatedly attempted to purchase the colony, but so far, all efforts have met with failure.
- (ξ) **Xi Ithilia:** Known also as the Bahr system, the main world is largely a vulcan mining and industrial colony. Due to the world's fast rate of rotation, a ridge of fairly substantial mountains have built up along the equator, somewhat reminiscent of a great wall when seen from orbit. It is in this earthquake country that most of the planet's dense, radioactive minerals are found. It is said that though life is a constant risk on this world, due to the quakes, it is nonetheless a logical place to mine, as "The Wall" is where the best mineral are, and hence, the best profits.
