Lotus won their lawsuit against Paperback Software and immediately sued Borland.

They won against Paperback because VP Planner uses the same menu structure as 1-2-3. They are suing Borland because Quattro Pro's menus *have similarities* with those of 1-2-3.

According to the Wall Street Journal, Lotus "claims that Quattro Pro's use of the 'C' key to denote what type of currency to use on a spreadsheet, as well as the use of 'FR' for file retrieve, constitute infringements on Lotus's 1-2-3."

We have just marked the 100th anniversary of the first antitrust law.
