University's indirect cost rate is predetermined.

Additionally, if federal or state matching funds are involved, the research or project may be subject to agreement(s) between the University and the funding governmental agency. Finally, if the University has previously received or is currently receiving other private funding for similar research or projects, the rights to and ownership of the research or project University is conducting for Sponsor may be limited by University's agreement(s) such other private funding entities.

Therefore, to the extent that the terms and conditions in the above referenced document:

- (1) conflict with statutory or regulatory requirements governing University;
- (2) conflict with applicable agreements between the University and governmental agencies; or
- (3) are subject to limitations imposed by agreements with other private entities,

such terms and conditions cannot be accepted by the University and cannot apply to the research being performed by the University. If the University is awarded funding by Sponsor, the University will provide Sponsor with a marked copy of the Subcontract Agreement which will include the changes required by the University.
