RussParis: "King Porter Stomp" was a Fletcher Henderson song. Benny Goodman did it too.
CESE11: I like King Porter Stomp
NCMC Mercy: Sounds like this album is going to have some excellent tunage on it.
CESE11: Rimsky, did you know that she was going to be here?
Raydioface: sounds delicious! (the album, I mean)

Raydioface: Caddy and Banzini?

NCMC Mercy: That's funny CESE.

Raydioface: I knew reading liner notes would pay off some day.....
NCMCRimsky: CESE, LDorado Kaddy and Guido Panzini.

JAWebster2: I have a great Atlantic r&b compilation w/ liners by L Dorado Kaddy.
Raydioface: ooh---I have that one too!
RussParis: Well, I've gotta run. 8:00pm here and time to put the little monsters -- I mean children -- to bed.
JAWebster2: H also shows up on a Richie Cole record.

Jblconti34: How old was Janis when she did Young Generation?

JAWebster2: If you can find the Laurel Canyon or Loved Ones singles, they're also great.

NCMCRimsky: I don't know... 18... 19... is that right Jess.?

JAWebster2: Janis was 12 when they cut the Red Bird single.

NCMCRimsky: Oh... gosh!

JAWebster2: It was in 1965.\

Raydioface: And where would one find this stuff....peruse the flea markets? (12?! Yikes!)

JAWebster2: Check Goldmine (A collectors mag)

JAWebster2: I found Laurel Canyon in a used record store in New York.

JAWebster2: I'll let you all know if I ever encounter other copies.

JAWebster2: I gotta go now, and introduce my fiancee to my grandparents.

JAWebster2: Lisa, I'll talk to you about the trivia thing, ok?
Ampdood: Radical!
Raydioface: Hey yall...it's been fun, but I'm gonna hang it up too.....see ya on the board....Night!
Jblconti34: Anyone else have Rock Rhythm & Blues...TMT has one song on this compilation?

CESE11: Hansi..."Vocalese"
Jblconti34: Cese, this is good, I found this tape at work in our company store for \$2!!
CESE11: cool, Brenda!!
HansiBrian: Want a bit of trivia?
Jblconti34: Janis sings lead on "I Wanna Be Your Girl", the whole album is 50's oriented...
HansiBrian: I used to live next to their keyboard player, in the late 70's
Jblconti34: Cool Hansi...
CESE11: kewl :)
Jblconti34: Tell us more Hansi
CESE11: did you guys know that I went to university w/Harry Conick, Jr?
NCMCRimsky: HansiBrian, wow!
NCMCRimsky: CESE, no... did you know him?
HansiBrian: Nice guy a little different. Anyone know his name? Dave something, maybe?
CESE11: he was in one of my classes
NCMC Mercy: CESE, Really?
NCMC Mercy: Wow.
CESE11: yes, really
NCMC Mercy: Cool.
Jblconti34: Harry Connick, wow, what was his major?
CESE11: don't remember...music, I think...
GCleven689: music has deteriorated since 69
NCMC Mercy: Well, that makes sense, CESE. ::grin::
Jblconti34: I had to ask, you know, Huey Lewis has a Masters in Engineering.
HansiBrian: With some small pockets of hope
CESE11: I didn't know that!!

NCMCRimsky: CESE, great!!!... You know Jerry Wichinsky will be here tonight.
CESE11: Great hosting tonight!! Oh, and Mercy wasnt bad either.....lol
NCMCRimsky: Corey also makes a mean Mushroom soup!
CESE11: Bonne nuit!!
NCMCRimsky: Cheryl just LOVES her baby!!
Jblconti34: Can I get some more TMT recipes? I remember we're gonna have a newsletter soon...
BBlex2: well, what do you think of kmfdm
NCMCRimsky: Jblconti, Yes. a new one is due out soon!!!
Jblconti34: Cheryl took a lot of weight off quickly, huh, after her baby was born...

NCMCRimsky: Jblconti, yeah... she exersized... stationary bike etc..
