SwingPath Button

The PATH Button draws lines on the video area and shows the exact swingpath of the golf club or golfers hands throughout the swing. This takes a little getting used to but with practice becomes very easy.

Notes: Throughout this process the Right mouse button advances the frames of video and the Left mouse button draws the lines. You cannot move the frames of video backwards while the swingpath button is on.

- 1. Load a golfer.
- 2. Positon the video so the golfer is ready to start his/her backswing.
- 3. Click on the Path button.
- 4. Use the left mouse button and click on the center of the clubhead (or hands). This is the starting point of our swingpath.
- 5. Click on the right mouse button and advance the frames of video until the clubhead moves away from the starting point.
- 6. Click the left mouse button on the center of the clubhead again. The line drawn shows the exact swingpath of the club.
- 7. Repeat steps 5 and 6 until you have captured all of the swingpath you are interested in seeing.
- 8. Click the Path button again to turn the button off.
