1.5 Making programs working

How to get a program working?

Nearly all programs on this CD, which are installed to run, need assigns, certain files in certain directories, their own fonts and libraries and so on, which they have to find in order to run correct.

Therefore we created setup-files to put the needed assigns into the system. Don't worry, there will be no change in the system, after the reset everything will be gone.

We put two ways to integrate the assigns into the system on the users disposal:

1. The costly method:

Before starting a program the setup-files have to be opened separately by double-clicking them.

You have to start the 8-cornered grey icons marked with 'Assign' and called "programname-setup". The icons are in the respective program directory next to the icon of the main program.

Furthermore the "Find-All" icon has to be opened and the libraries, fonts, etc. have to be found in the programs of the CD. (You have to do this only once, after you put the CD inside, as this setup is valid for all programs at the time).

Additional the RexxMast has to be activated if you start a programe which needs it.

Advantage:

There are not so many assigns integrated in the system. There are only the assigns of the programs needed of the system.

Disadvantage:

You have to open the respective setup icon before starting the program. (If you forget that, some programs will even crash).

2. The easy method:

Just start the 'GLOBAL-ASSIGN' after putting the CD into the drive. Then all assigns and allocations for all programs on the CD will be opened automaticaly. (The icon "Find-All" has not to be opened as this batch-file is part of the GLOBAL-ASSIGN).

The RexxMast is activated automatically through this script, too. You don't need to start it separately.

Advantage:

You don't have to think about everything as it is working after starting the program.

Disadvantage:

You have a lot of assigns in the system. This needs more memory than the first reader but it is in any case more comfortable.

We recomend the second method!

Here is an other suggestion:

As a textviewer the program 'Most' from Uwe Roehm is used.

If a read-me-file is opened there will be searched for 'most' first in the C:-directory of the boot-partition and then in the C:-directory of the CD.

As the access time of the CD-ROM-drive is not very fast compared with hard-discs it is clear that after some time it gets on your nervs to wait until 'most' and afterwards the text-file are loaded.

If you want to speed up the access on 'most' you have to copy 'most' into the C:-directory of the boot-partition. There it will be found faster and be faster at your disposal.

1.7 The Compressed directory

The use of the packed files

What?

In the 'Compressed' directory you can find packed demoversions of most

demoversions, installed on the CD.

Why?

This directory is to enable the user to install the software he/she wants to test more detailed on his/her hard-disc.

How?

You have to unpack the packed files with the respective packer and to install each demo with the instuctions for installation. Because of legal reasons the needed packer cannot be found on this CD.

Why?

In very few cases it is enough to copy only the complete program directories of the installed demo-versions from the CD on your hard disc partition.

1.8 Problems

Problems with this CD?

Using this CD there shouldn't be any problems.

This CD was tested by several betatesters on several computer configurations before the CD was pressed. All mistakes of the instalation or configuration should be removed.

Problems with ready installed software?

There could be problems with some programs (luckily this are only a few).

Some are not a 100 % conform to the system or don't stick to the given rules and spezifications.

e.g. you can't close them properly or they leave opened windows on the workbench after ending and so on.

Very view programs don't run 'out of the CD' because they try to write on the data carrier on which they are. You can find a note in the read-me-files of this programs. In that cases you have to instal it on your hard-disc.

An other solution for this problem could be to copy only the whole drawer of the program to RAM or to HD and to run it from there. But, this solutions works only if TGAE is inserted and assigned.

Most of the programs try to write on the CD but go on normally after an error message.

Which configurations are needed?

This depends on each program. However OS2.x and 1MB are the minimum (a lot of programs shouldn't work with this configuration). Better would be OS3.x and 4MB or more. The more MB and Mhz the better.

We installed the demos to run with a possible low configuration.

Installing some programs we had the choice between PAL- and NTSC-installation. We took the NTSC-installation as this one runs more possible on PAL-Amigas as vice versa.

Where ever possible we also installed not-FPU-program versions as not everybody has a FPU.

Who wants to use this demos at the optimum of his/her computer configuration should unpack the packed files ot of the compressed directory and install them on his/her hard-disc.

1.9 Future

We are already planning a following CD, which will contain demoversions of commercially distributed software. We have already confirmations from some companies, which are none existend on this CD (for time reasons) because they are providing us with some 'specials'. We don't want to say more at this stage. :-)
