17TH AT THE QUARRY GOLF CLUB, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS.

386 / 357 / 309 / 266 YARDS, PAR 4.

One more quarry hole, this time at The Quarry in San Antonio. Missouri architect, Keith Foster, has routed the entire back nine in an old limestone pit.

Every one of The Quarry's holes is dramatic, but none more so than the 17th, a dogleg left (or straightaway, depending upon the tee used) to a fairway perched on a little quarry shelf, with a high rock wall to the right and an abrupt drop off to the left.

The farther you drive it, the narrower the fairway gets. Hit the fairway, and the approach to the generous green is a snap. Just don't hit that approach too far, pull it left, or push it right.

It's the tee shot that counts. That's why the club named this hole, "Reload".
