History

This program was designed since I became fed up with having to have Program Manager maximized or just "up" when I wanted to run an application. I also wanted a floating text box in which I could type exe command lines. Voila!

Files

There are just two files. Both of which **must be in C:\windows directory!!!**

cw_prog.exe

cw_prog.ini

I'd recommend that you place cw_prog.exe in your startup group. Note that it will minimize Program Manager when it is loaded.

The contents of the ini file are self-explanatory. But I'll go over them anyway:

[LABEL]

This is where you specify the text of the label that appears on the bar

[HINTS]

The first eight buttons on the bar are fully customisable. In this section you can specify the text that appears in each button's hint box.

[PATHS]

This specifies the command line for each of the buttons. Note that the buttons are numbered 1 to 11, left from right.
