## cw\_prog.exe cw\_prog.ini

I'd recommend that you place cw\_prog.exe in your startup group. Note that it will minimize Program Manager when it is loaded.

The contents of the ini file are self-explanatory. But I'll go over them anyway:

#### **ILABEL**

This is where you specify the text of the label that appears on the bar

# [HINTS]

The first eight buttons on the bar are fully customisable. In this section you can specify the text that appears in each button's hint box.

#### [PATHS]

This specifies the command line for each of the buttons. Note that the buttons are numbered 1 to 11, left from right.
