property Active: Boolean; (Read-Only)

The Active property is used to query the state of $\underline{\mathsf{TBizCalc}}$. When this property is True the calculator is loaded. Check the $\underline{\mathsf{Visible property}}$ to determine if the calculator is shown or hidden. This property is read only.

Caption property

property Caption: String;

The Caption property is used to set text that appears in the Tile Bar of the calculator popup window.

Position property

property Position: TPosition;

The Position property is used control the location of the calculator popup window. This property is functional the same as the position property for Delphi Forms.

Copy property

property Copy: Boolean;

The copy property is used to enable or disable the calculators copy function. When set to true the user can copy selected data from the calculators tape display to the clipboard. This property also controls displaying of the copy menu item.

UserClose property

property UserClose: Boolean;

The UserClose property is used to enable or disable the calculators close function. When set to true the user can close the calculator by select exit from the popup menu or via the system menu(-). This property also controls displaying of the Exit menu item.

Note: This option doesn't actually destroy the calculator form, but rather performs the equivalent of the <u>Hide Method</u>.

Left property

property Left: Integer;

This property controls the positioning of the calculator popup window.

property Print: Boolean;

The print property is used to enable or disable the calculators Print function. When set to true the user can print the data from the calculators tape display. This property also controls displaying of the print menu item.

Text property

property Text: String; (Read-Only)

The Text property is used to retreive calculation results from the Calculators display. This property is read only. Calculation result are placed in the text property when any of the following methods are performed:

property Top: Integer;

This property controls the positioning of the calculator popup window.

property Visible: Boolean; (Read-Only)

The Visible property is used to query the state of <u>TBizCalc</u>. When this property is True the calculator is shown. Check the <u>Active property</u> to determine if the calculator is loaded. This property is read only.

property Color: TColor;

The Color property is used to control the canvas color of $\underline{\text{TBizCalc}}$. Changing this property will have the effect of changing the background color of the calculator.

Font property

property Font: TFont;

The Font property is used to control the font of $\underline{\text{TBizCalc}}$ buttons. Changing this property will have the effect of changing the Font, color, size and or style of the text that appears on calculator buttons.

OnResult event

property OnResult: TNotifyEvent;

The OnResult Event is generated whenever the user selects the Equals button of $\underline{\text{TBizCalc}}$. This event is usefull if you want to capture the results of a calculation. When this event occurs the $\underline{\text{Text Property}}$ is updated with the results of the calculation.

OnClose event

property OnClose: TNotifyEvent;

The OnClose Event is generated whenever the user exits the calculator of $\underline{\text{TBizCalc}}$.

Help property

property Help: Boolean;

The Help property is used to enable or disable the calculators Help facility. When set to true the user can invoke help from the calculators popup menu or by pressing F1. This property also controls displaying of the Help menu item.

Note: Setting this property to true requires that the BCALC.HLP file be in the Application directory or in the Windows directory. You may use the BCALC.HLP file distributed with the component or create your own, but the control will always look for the file by this name.

Function Execute: Boolean;

The Execute method is used to launch the popup calculator. Check the <u>Active</u> and <u>Visible</u> property to determine if the calculator is already loaded and or shown. Note this method will launch and show the calculator even if a previous Hide method has been performed.

Function Close: Boolean;

The Close method is used to quit the popup calculator and free its resources. When quitting an application, that contains this $\underline{\text{TBizCalc}}$ component, perform the close method before ending the program. Check the $\underline{\text{Active}}$ and $\underline{\text{Visible}}$ properties to determine if the calculator is loaded and or shown.

The Hide method is used to make the calculator invisible. The <u>Show Method</u> will restore, show, or bring to front the calculator window. Check the <u>Active property</u> and <u>Visible property</u> to determine if the calculator is already loaded and or shown.

The Retreive method is used return a calculation result. When the Retreive method is performed the results from the calculator display are placed in the <u>Text Property</u>. In addition to the Retreive method any of the following methods will also cause the Text property to be updated.
