<u>Use</u>

This is a dead simple component (and I mean that emphatically!) which basically returns the text associated with a value (less than 32) returned by the WinExec function. The function that is being called is **custCheckWinExec**. For example (assuming that you have installed a TCheckWinExec component onto your form):
