Chapter 1: Introducing HiJaak 95

Page 1-4: In the last sentence in the last paragraph, replace "HiJaak Catalog icon" with "HiJaak Catalog Setup icon."

Page 1-10: The following formats are *not* supported in this version: GCA--IBM GOCA, MET--PM Metafile. The following formats are supported, but are not listed in the table: CMX--Corel Metafile Exchange (source only), PSD--Photoshop (source/destination), PNG--Portable Network Graphics (source only). PCD--Photo CD should be listed as Kodak Photo CD.

Chapter 2: Installing HiJaak 95

Page 2-1: HiJaak 95 requires about 10 megabytes of free disk space to install.

Page 2-2: Step 6, second sentence--replace "Name" with "User Name."

Page 2-3: Step 7, fourth paragraph, second sentence--replace "Browse dialog box" with "Browse for Folder dialog box."

Page 2-7: Step 2, replace both occurrences of "HiJaak Catalog" with "HiJaak Catalog Setup."

Page 2-8: Step 3: Contents--remove the reference to reconnecting file information. Add another tab: "Formats--allows you to set up which formats and format extensions will be recognized by HiJaak 95."

Page 2-9: Remove step 6.

Page 2-10: To Start HiJaak 95... replace the Keyboard instructions with the following: "Press CTRL+Esc to pull up the Start menu. Press P to open the Programs submenu. Press H to highlight the HiJaak 95 folder and press enter to open the submenu. Press H to highlight HiJaak 95 and Enter to run it. Note that if you have more than one folder beginning with the letter 'P' or 'H,' you may have to press the letter more than once to highlight the correct folder or program."

Page 2-11: To Select a Pull-down menu\Keyboard. To the beginning of the sentence, add "Press the Alt key..."

Chapter 3: Getting More Information

Page 3-1: HiJaak 95 Help and Troubleshooting Help: all help files (*.hlp) are located in the C:\HIJAAK95\BIN directory, not the C:\HIJAAK95 directory.

Page 3-2: Replace the first sentence with "HiJaak 95 online reference files are located in the HIJAAK95 and the HIJAAK95\BIN directories."

Page 3-3: Step 3: replace the command line to run HiJaak 95 Help with the following: **WINHELP C:\HIJAAK95\BIN\HIJAAK.HLP**.

Page 3-7: Step 2, paragraph 1, last sentence--replace "Express" with "Minimum Database Size."

Page 3-14: Step 3: replace the command line to run Troubleshooting Help with the following: **WINHELP C:\HIJAAK95\BIN\TBLSHOOT.HLP**.

Chapter 4: Learning HiJaak 95

Page 4-2: Add Step 5: "To exit Explorer, pull down the File menu and click on Close."

Page 4-4: Replace steps 3-6 with the following:

3. In the right side of the Explorer window, double-click on the HiJaak95 folder. Double-click on the Tutorial folder. The right side of the Explorer displays the contents of the C:\HIJAAK95\TUTORIAL folder. Notice that there are a number of thumbnails with the text "Needs Update." These thumbnails have not been added to the HiJaak Catalog.
4. To start updating the Needs Update thumbnails and adding them to the HiJaak Catalog, click once on the Update icon in the taskbar. This icon appears as a red light in the task tray. You will see the Update Priority slider. This slider allows you to increase, decrease or turn off thumbnail updating. Note that the higher the priority you give to thumbnail updating, the less responsive your interface becomes.
5. Click on the slide bar and drag it to the top of the of the slider. Release the mouse button. HiJaak 95 quickly begins updating thumbnails; the Needs Update thumbnails are replaced with bitmapped representations of the graphics files. Notice the Update icon; it has change to a green and yellow flashing light.
6. When all of the thumbnails have been updated, you should lower the update priority. To lower the priority, click on the slide bar and drag closer to the bottom of the slider. To turn off updating altogether, click on the Pause button. To close the Update pop-up, click anywhere outside of it.

Page 4-5: Working Tips, Tip 1--Replace every occurrence of "Background check box" with "Pause button." After selecting, this button will change to Resume; click on it to resume background updating.

Page 4-9: Steps 6,7,8--Replace every occurrence of "Convert To dialog box" with "HiJaak Convert dialog box."

Page 4-10: Working Tips, Tip 2--Remove the reference to "Change a Font." Change a Font is not supported in this version of HiJaak 95.

Tip 3--Remove **-setfile.set** from the command line. This parameter is no longer necessary.

Page 4-17: Add to Step 5: Click on OK (after deselecting Auto Hide check box). Add to Step 6: "Click on the minimize button in the HiJaak 95 application window."

Page 4-18: Step 10, last paragraph--At this point, Windows Explorer in minimized. To exit Explorer, click the secondary mouse button on the icon in the taskbar and select Close.
