Introduction

Quote is a simple program that gives you a message each time it is run. It is intended to be placed in the systems startup folder. This allows it to run each time your machine is booted. The message changes each time the program is ran. The program also displays the last two times the program was run. This is just to let you know the last time you started your machine.

Installation

- Drag the Quote program into the folder labeled Startup Items in your system folder.

or

- Make an alias of the Quote program and drop the alias into the folder labeled Startup Items in your system folder.

Standard disclaimer:

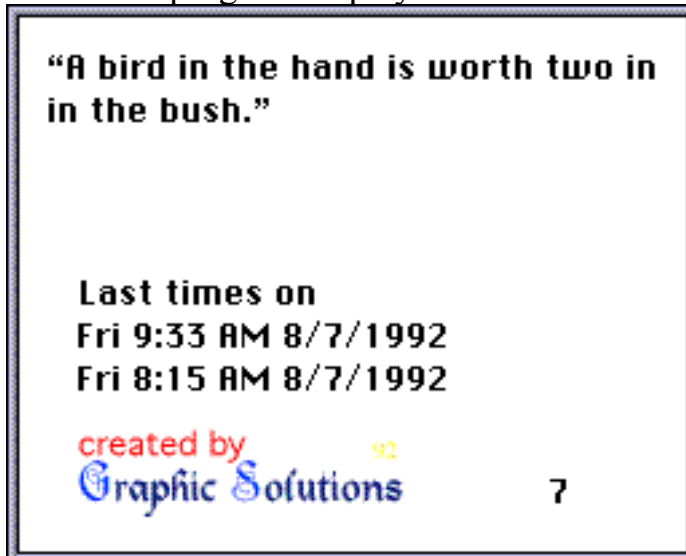
