Main Menu

This window allows you to select images either by category (click on associated picture) or by artist's name.

Thumbnail Window

Selected images are shown as thumbnails. Double click on them to see the real pictures along with information about the artists. Due to different color settings, the colors of the thumbnails might be distorted. However, this does not affect the real-size pictures. They should always appear correct.

Slide Show

You can see the slide show of the selected group of images by clicking on the corresponding option in the Thumbnail window. The show can be either automatic with various time intervals or manual (you will have to press the Space bar every time you want to change the picture). Click on “Settings” during the show to set up your preferences.
