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### Write - PICNIC.WRI

Contains the title of the application running in the window, in this case Write. The title bar also shows the name of the file that's open. Drag the title bar to move an application window on the screen.

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# Minimize button



• Click the Minimize button to shrink the Write window to an icon.

## Maximize button



• Click the Maximize button to enlarge the Write window to its maximum size.

### scroll arrow



An arrow on either end of a scroll bar used to move the contents of the window or list box.

• Click a scroll arrow to move the contents.

# scroll bar

A bar that appears at the right and/or bottom edge of a window whose contents aren't completely visible. Each scroll bar contains two scroll arrows and a scroll box, which allow you to move the contents of the window or list box.

• Click a scroll bar to move the contents one screen.

### scroll box



A small box in a scroll bar. The scroll box shows the position of what's currently in the window or list box relative to the contents of the entire file or list.

Drag the scroll box to display another part of the contents.

Ruler

Displayed across the top of the window when you choose the Ruler On command from the Document menu. Use the Ruler to view and apply paragraph formatting.

### left tab icon



Sets a left-aligned tab. Characters are inserted to the right of the tab stop.Select the icon and then click the Ruler where you want the tab to appear. Þ.





Sets a decimal tab.

When you type text at a decimal tab stop, the characters you type are inserted to the left of the tab stop until you type a decimal point. The decimal point is inserted at the tab stop, and any additional characters you type are inserted to the right of the decimal point.

Select the icon and then click the Ruler where you want the tab to appear.

single space icon



 Formats paragraphs single spaced.
 Click the icon to format selected paragraphs or a paragraph in which the insertion point appears. Þ

# 1 1/2 space icon



 Changes line spacing of paragraphs to 1 1/2 spaces.
 Click the icon to format selected paragraphs or a paragraph in which the insertion point appears. Þ

# double space



 Formats paragraphs double spaced.
 Click the icon to format selected paragraphs or a paragraph in which the insertion point appears. Þ

left aligned icon



Aligns paragraphs or pictures with the left margin.
Click the icon to format a selected paragraph or picture, or a paragraph in which the insertion point appears.

### centered icon



Centers paragraphs or pictures between the left and right margins.
Click the icon to format a selected paragraph or picture, or a paragraph in which the insertion point appears.

right aligned icon



Aligns paragraphs or pictures with the right margin.
Click the icon to format a selected paragraph or picture, or a paragraph in which the insertion point appears.

justified icon



Aligns paragraphs with both the left and right margins.
Click the icon to format a selected paragraph or picture, or a paragraph in which the insertion point appears.

# » left indent marker > first line indent marker

left indent marker indents paragraphs from the left margin.

first line indent marker indents the first line of paragraphs. By default, the first line indent marker appears as a small white square on top of the left indent marker.

• Drag the left indent marker to change the indent of selected paragraphs, or a paragraph in which the insertion point appears.

• Drag the first line indent marker to change the indent of the first line in selected paragraphs, or a paragraph in which the insertion point appears.

# right indent marker

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Indents paragraphs from the right margin.
 Drag the right indent marker to change the indent of selected paragraphs, or a pagraph in which the insertion point appears.

#### Swimming, boating, fishing, volleyball and baseball games text

Text you type appears in the Write window. Place the insertion point where you want text to appear and start typing. Þ

#### Two music stages selected text

Text that is highlighted with key combinations or with the mouse. You select text before carrying out an action such as copying the text or changing its character formatting.
Point to the first character you want to select, drag the pointer, and let go of the mouse button at

the last character you want to select.

# insertion point

The place where text will be inserted when you type. The insertion point appears as a flashing vertical bar in the Write window. The text you type appears to the left of the insertion point, which is pushed to the right as you type.

Click the mouse pointer in a body of text to move the insertion point.





Example of a picture that has been created in another Windows application and pasted into this Write document. Click the picture to select it.

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# mouse pointer

The cursor on the screen that follows the mouse's movement and indicates which area of the screen will be affected when you click the mouse's button. The pointer appears as an I-beam when it's over text and as a pointer when it's in the selection area.

Move the mouse to move the pointer.

#### selection area

Invisible area that extends vertically along the left margin of the Write window. Use the selection area to select blocks of text. The mouse pointer slants to the right when it is in the selection area.

document end marker x

Marks the end of the document.

## manual page break

A page break you insert.

Page breaks divide one printed page from another. A manual page break is marked by a dotted line whereas an automatic page break is marked by double arrows at the left edge of the window.

Press CTRL+ENTER to insert a page break.

### automatic page break »

Page break inserted when you print or choose the Repaginate command from the File menu.

Page breaks divide one printed page from another. An automatic page break is marked by double arrows at the left edge of the window whereas a manual page break is marked by a dotted line.

Choose Repaginate from the File menu to view or change automatic page breaks.

# page status area



Shows the page number of the text appearing at the top of the window. Choose Repaginate from the File menu to view pagination in your document. Þ

# application window

The main window for an application, in this case the Write window. It contains the application's menu bar and main workspace. The Write application window can contain text or graphics.

# window border



The outside edge of a window. Drag the window border to change the size of the window. ۲
