#### Overview

Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT is a small utility that will allow you to load and display the ICON resources found in any disk file or application program.

### **Icon Extraction**

Icon Extractor allows you to select ICON resources to be saved as individual ICO files.

#### **Clipboard Copying**

Selected icons can also be copied directly to the MS Windows Clipboard as small bitmap images. From here they may easily be pasted into most Icon Editor applications and utilities.

#### **Drag & Drop Interface**

You may also drag file icons directly on to the Icon Extractor's main window to quickly open and view the ICON resources found in the specified disk file.

#### **File Formats**

Icon Extractor reads DLL, EXE, ICO, ICL, IL and NIL icon file formats.

#### **Desktop Locations**

Icon Extractor's location on the desktop is saved when the program is exited. Whenever you start Icon Extractor it will reappear on the desktop where you last placed it. Icon Extractor property sheet locations are also stored and reused the next time they are opened.

### **Taskbar Tray**

Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT can be optionally configured to place its program icon in the Taskbar Icon Notification Tray. This option provides a simple means of keeping the taskbar button region clear for other running programs.

# **Installing Icon Extractor**

#### Installation

To install Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT on your computer simply create a new, empty folder and place the files; ICONEX.EXE, ICONEX.HLP and ICONEX.CNT there.

- The Icon Extractor Application
- The Windows 95/NT Help File
- The Help Contents File

To integrate Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT with the MS Windows Explorer select the Icon Extractor <u>Explorer Setup</u> property sheet while Icon Extractor is running.

**Note** If you have an earlier version of Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT installed on your computer, simply replace the ICONEX.EXE, ICONEX.HLP and ICONEX.CNT files with the newer versions.

**Note** The ICONEX.INI file is no longer used and can be deleted. The various application settings specified in the <u>lcon Extractor Options</u> property sheet as well as the main window's size and location on the desktop are now stored in the MS Windows 95/NT <u>System Registry</u>.

**Note** Some earlier versions of Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT included a ICONEX.WRI documentation file. This file has been replaced by the ICONEX.HLP file and can now be deleted.

**Warning** If you rename the ICONEX.EXE file you must also rename the HLP file using the same basename. For example if you change the Icon Extractor application file name to NewName.exe, rename the help file to NewName.hlp. Do not rename the ICONEX.CNT file however. The HLP and CNT files *must* reside in the same folder as the Icon Extractor application file itself.

# **Configuring Icon Extractor**

#### **Icon Extractor Options**

Select the **File | Options** menu item to display the Icon Extractor Options property sheet. This window will allow you to change the various Icon Extractor program settings listed below.

#### Launch Multiple Instances

Check this item to allow more than one instance of Icon Extractor to be run on the desktop.

#### Reopen the Last File Used at Startup

Check this box to reopen the last file used when Icon Extractor is launched.

#### Show Tool Bar Tips

Check this item to display small popup tip windows when the mouse pointer is placed over <u>toolbar ribbon</u> pushbuttons. A short description of the button currently beneath the mouse will be shown when this item is checked.

#### Place Icon in the Taskbar Tray

Check this item to display a small Icon Extractor program icon in the Taskbar Icon Notification Tray. If this item is selected and the Icon Extractor window is minimized a button will not be added to the Taskbar, to restore the Icon Extractor window on the desktop press the small icon in the taskbar tray instead. This option is available to keep the taskbar free for other running programs.

**Note** When this option is selected, clicking on the Close box in the upper-right hand corner of the window title bar will minimize Icon Extractor instead of closing the application. To quit Icon Extractor use the **File | Exit** menu command or the **Ctrl+Q** keyboard shortcut.

#### **Confirm Program Exit**

Check this item to confirm quitting Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT. When this option is selected you will be prompted to confirm your intention to exit Icon Extractor and return to the MS Explorer desktop. This item is useful if you run Icon Extractor from the tray and wish to avoid accidental exits when you right-click on the Icon Extractor tray icon.

#### **SLR Camera Sound when Copying**

Check this box to play an SLR camera shutter sound when copying selected icons to the MS Windows Clipboard.

#### Specify an Icon Editing Application

The Icon Editor you specify here will be opened when you press the Edit button on the toolbar ribbon. Specify the full drive and path when defining your preferred icon editing utility, or press the browse [...] button to the right of the entry field to select an icon editing program using the standard MS Windows File Explorer.

#### Specify a Background Color for Clipboard Copying

The color you specify here will be used as the background when copying selected ICON resources to the MS Windows Clipboard. Press the **Select** button to open the standard MS Windows Color Picker.

#### Sounds with Warning Dialog Boxes

Check this box to play a short beep sound when Icon Extractor displays a warning dialog box or an error occurs.

#### OK

Press this button when you have completed your selection of Icon Extractor program options. When you press this button the Icon Extractor Options property sheet will be closed and your settings will be saved.

#### Cancel

Press this button to close the Icon Extractor Options property sheet without making any changes. If you have made any changes to the option settings, and then press this button your changes will not be used, and your previous settings will remain in use.

#### Help

Press this button to open the Icon Extractor Help window and go directly to the Configuring Icon Extractor topic.

**Note** The options you have selected will be saved when you press the **OK** button. The desktop location of the Icon Extractor Options window itself will also be stored. Your settings will be saved in the MS Windows 95/NT <u>System Registry</u>.

# **Icon Extractor Explorer Setup**

#### **Icon Extractor Explorer Setup**

Select the <u>Help</u> | <u>Setup</u> menu item to display the Icon Extractor Setup property sheet. This window will allow you to integrate Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT with the Microsoft Windows 95/NT Explorer. Use this command to create and remove MS Explorer shortcuts.

#### Create a Start Menu Item

Check this item to create a Icon Extractor Start Menu entry. The Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT program will be located in the Software by Design folder on the Programs menu. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a Icon Extractor item already exists in the Software by Design folder.

#### Remove this Start Menu Item

Check this item to remove the Icon Extractor entry located in the Software by Design folder on the Programs menu. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a Icon Extractor item does not already exist in the Software by Design folder.

#### Create a Desktop Icon

Check this item to create a lcon Extractor for Windows 95/NT program icon on the Explorer desktop. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a lcon Extractor desktop icon already exists.

#### Remove Icon from the Desktop

Check this item to remove the Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT program icon from the Explorer desktop. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a Icon Extractor desktop icon does not already exist.

#### Create a Startup Folder Item

Check this item to automatically run Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT whenever Microsoft Windows is started. This option creates a Icon Extractor program icon in the MS Windows Explorer Startup folder. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a Icon Extractor startup item already exists in the Startup folder.

#### Remove the Startup Folder Item

Check this item to remove Icon Extractor from the MS Windows Explorer Startup folder. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a Icon Extractor startup item does not already exist in the Startup folder.

#### OK

Press this button when you have completed your selection of MS Explorer shortcuts. When you press this button the Icon Extractor Setup property sheet will be closed and the MS Explorer shortcuts you have selected will be created or removed.

#### Cancel

Press this button to close the Icon Extractor Explorer Setup property sheet without creating or removing any MS Explorer shortcuts.

#### Help

Press this button to open the Icon Extractor Help window and go directly to the Icon Extractor Explorer Setup topic.

## File Menu

#### File Menu Commands

The File menu provides commands to work with the icon files used by Icon Extractor. A short description of each item follows:

#### **O**pen

Opens an existing icon file, and loads it for viewing. When this item is selected the standard MS Windows Explorer file browser will be displayed, use this window to select the icon file you wish to work with. The **Ctrl+O** shortcut can be used for this command

#### **Properties**

Displays a small window showing file properties for the currently selected icon file. This window will display the file's name, folder location, size, last modification date and file access permissions. The **Alt+Enter** shortcut can be used for this command.

#### Close

Closes the currently active icon file. The Ctrl+W shortcut can be used for this command.

#### Save Selection

Saves the currently selected icon as an individual ICO file. The Ctrl+S shortcut can be used for this command.

#### Options

Opens the <u>Icon Extractor Options</u> property sheet and allows you to change Icon Extractor program settings. Use this command to configure the Icon Extractor program.

#### Recent Files

This command displays a sub-menu containing up to 9 recently viewed icon libraries. Select a file name from this list to quickly reopen a recently viewed icon file.

#### Exit

Closes the Icon Extractor program and returns control to the Explorer desktop. The Ctrl+Q shortcut can be used for this command.

Tip Commonly used File commands can be invoked using shortcut keys or buttons on the toolbar ribbon.

# **Edit Menu**

### **Edit Menu Commands**

The Edit menu provides commands used to copy selected icons. A short description of each item follows:

### <u>C</u>opy

Copies the currently selected ICON resource to the Clipboard. The icon will be converted into a small 32x32 pixel bitmap image. From the Clipboard the image can be pasted into most popular Icon Editing applications and utilities. The **Ctrl+C** shortcut can be used for this command.

#### <u>E</u>dit

Launches the Icon Editor you specified in the <u>Icon Extractor Options</u> property sheet. The **Ctrl+E** shortcut can be used for this command.

Tip Commonly used Edit commands can be invoked using shortcut keys or buttons on the toolbar ribbon.

## **View Menu**

#### **View Menu Commands**

The View menu provides commands used to change Icon Extractor display options. These items provide a means of changing the Icon Extractor window appearance. A short description of each item follows:

#### Previous Page

Use this command to display the previous page of ICON resources found in the current icon file. The **PgUp** shortcut can be used for this command.

#### Next Page

Use this command to display the next page of ICON resources found in the current icon file. The **PgDn** shortcut can be used for this command.

#### **M**inimize

Minimizes the Icon Extractor window to a button or icon on the taskbar. The Ctrl+Y shortcut can be used for this command.

### Always on Top

Use this command to keep the Icon Extractor window top most on the desktop. When this item is checked the Icon Extractor window will float above all other non-topmost windows on the desktop. This item is useful if you normally run Icon Extractor with a small window that would be easily obscured by other applications. The **Ctrl+T** shortcut can be used for this command.

Tip Commonly used View commands can be invoked using shortcut keys or buttons on the toolbar ribbon.

# **Help Menu**

#### **Help Menu Commands**

The Help menu provides commands used to get help with Icon Extractor operations. A short description of each item follows:

#### Contents

Opens the Icon Extractor Help window and displays the Table of Contents. The F1 shortcut can be used for this command.

#### Search

Opens Icon Extractor Help and displays the Search window. You can use this window to search for specific Icon Extractor help topics.

#### How to Use Help

Opens a Help window that explains how to use the MS Windows 95/NT Help program.

#### Register

Displays the Icon Extractor Shareware Registration Wizard. This wizard allows you to register Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT for authorized use.

#### Setup

Displays the Icon Extractor <u>Explorer Setup</u> property sheet. This window provides options to integrate Icon Extractor with the MS Windows Explorer. Use this window to create MS Explorer Start Menu items and desktop icons.

#### Web Site

Opens your web browser application and goes directly to the Software by Design web site on the Internet.

#### About Icon Extractor

Displays the Icon Extractor splash box. This window contains program information, the current version of Icon Extractor you are running and a program copyright notice. Click the mouse anywhere in this window to close it

Tip Commonly used Help commands can be invoked using shortcut keys or buttons on the toolbar ribbon.

## **Toolbar Buttons**

#### **Tool Ribbon Buttons**

Most commonly used Icon Extractor menu commands can also be quickly invoked by pressing a button on the toolbar ribbon displayed at the top of the main window.

These buttons work exactly the same way as the corresponding menu items that they duplicate.



Open - Open an icon file for viewing



Save - Save the selected icon as an ICO file



Properties - Show the current icon file's properties



Close - Close the currently active icon file



Copy - Copy the selected icon to the Clipboard



Edit - Open the default Icon Editor



Previous – display the previous page of icons



Next - display the next page of icons



Topmost - Make the Icon Extractor window topmost



Options - Open the <u>Icon Extractor Options</u> dialog



Help - Open this Help file



About - Show Icon Extractor splash box

**Tip** If the Show ToolBar Tips option is selected a small popup tip window will appear when the mouse pointer is placed over a button. A short description of what each button does can be viewed using this method.

# **Shortcut Keys**

Shortcut keys allow you to quickly invoke Icon Extractor menu commands without first displaying the menu and then selecting an item from it. The most commonly used Icon Extractor commands can be invoked using the following shortcut keys.

File Menu

Ctrl+O Open an existing icon file

Alt+Enter Show properties for the current icon file Ctrl+W

Close the current icon file Save selected icon as an ICO file Ctrl+S

Ctrl+Q Exit Icon Extractor, and return to the desktop

Edit Menu

Ctrl+C Copy the currently selected icon to the Clipboard

Ctrl+E Open the default Icon Editor

<u>V</u>iew Menu

**PgUp** Display the previous page of icons PgDn Display the next page of icons

Ctrl+Y Minimize Icon Extractor to a button or icon Ctrl+T Make the Icon Extractor window topmost

Display this Help file

Icon Extractor for Windows 95/NT stores configuration settings in the MS Windows 95/NT System Registry. These settings are updated automatically while Icon Extractor is running. There is no need to edit these settings manually.

If you insist upon editing these settings, you do so at your own risk. Icon Extractor automatically updates registry entries when it exits. If you edit these settings make sure Icon Extractor is not running while you edit them. If Icon Extractor is currently running your changes will be overwritten when Icon Extractor exits.

IconEx.gid MS Windows Help settings file. This file contains the Icon Extractor Help window size and desktop location

as well as any bookmarks you may have created.

IconEx.fts MS Windows Help word database. This file is created when you build a custom word list for Icon Extractor

Help files. This file is used to search for words and phrases in the Icon Extractor Help files.



### What is Shareware
