WXP5009	Operation Conflicts between early release RASport and FAXport	An abnormality has been reported in regards to the answering of the modem while RASport, FAXport and RAS were running simultaneously.
WXP5010	How to Install WINport from CD ROM Software Using SETUP and Upgrade Diskettes	When attempting to install the WINport software from the CD ROM provided, some people are not certain as to what steps are needed to be followed. This technical note will provide more detailed information on these steps to help ensure a successful installation.
