Good design techniques have been emphasized throughout the text. Apply your knowledge of Web design by analyzing the portfolio of a Web site design company. Present your analysis in a Web site by completing the following steps:

- a) Most Web site design companies showcase samples of Web sites they have designed. Use the Internet to locate a Web site design company and view their portfolio. Gather the following information about the company and the portfolio:
 - 1. List the company name and URL.
 - 2. List some of the services that the company provides.
 - 3. List of clients and links to their sites.
 - 4. Describe a site in the portfolios that seems to have used Flash.
 - 5. Explain how a site in one of the portfolios applies the concept of appropriateness.
 - 6. Explain how a site in one of the portfolios applies the concept of consistency.
 - 7. Explain how a site in one of the portfolios uses the concept of usability.
 - 8. Comment on whether you feel this would be a good Web design company to work for. Why or why not?
 - 9. Would you recommend this Web design company to a business that needs a Web site designed? Why or why not?
- b) Define a new Web site named Design Analysis in a folder named Design Analysis.
- c) Add three files to the Web site, naming them index.htm, analysis.htm, and conclusion.htm.
- d) Using a library item, add an appropriate footer that includes your name to each Web page document.
- e) Create content for the three Web page documents based on the information gathered in step (a).
- f) Apply design concepts to the Web page documents.
- g) Use a style sheet to format the Web page documents.
- h) Modify the index.htm Web page document to include a Flash animation.
- Check the spelling in each Web page document.
- j) View the Web page documents in a browser window and test the hyperlinks.
- k) Print a copy of each Web page document from the browser.
