

Race Track Web Site Project

Develop a Web site for an amateur car race event by completing the following steps:

- a) Define a new Web site named Race Track in a folder named Race Track.
- b) Add four files to the Web site, naming them index.htm, races.htm, statistics.htm, and location.htm.
- c) Define who the target audience would be for this Web site.
- d) Each Web page document should include:
 - tables for arranging content
 - a style sheet to format the content
 - appropriate page titles
 - a footer with copyright information and your name
- e) The individual Web page documents should include:
 - index.htm: a logo, contact information, hours of operation, event admission price, and a car race Flash animation
 - races.htm: a list of the featured races and at least one graphic
 - statistics.htm: a list of previous race results
 - location.htm: location information and directions or a map
- f) Check the spelling in all the Web page documents.
- g) Add keyword meta data with at least two appropriate keywords.
- h) Add description meta data with an appropriate description of the Web site.
- i) Test the HTML in each Web page document for compatibility with at least three browsers.
- j) Test the Web site for broken and missing links.
- k) Check the Web site for Missing Alt Text and Untitled Documents.
- l) Publish the Web site to a Local folder.
- m) Print a copy of each Web page document from the browser.
- n) In a word processor document, describe how this Web site would have to be maintained, then print a copy of the document.
