Please Note!!

If you only have 8 MB of RAM, a diminished 8 MB version of Peeping Pete will be installed. If in the future you upgrade to 16MB or more, reinstall Pete to use the full version.

INSTALLATION PROCEDURES

Be sure to turn off all unnecessary programs.

WINDOWS 95

1. Start Windows 95
2. Insert *Peeping Pete* into your CD ROM drive.
3. Select the START button and then select RUN.

In the RUN window enter D:SETUP.EXE and Hit OK. If your CD Drive is not drive D, then replace the letter D with the correct letter of your CD Drive.

4. Double click the *Peeping Pete* icon within the *Council* group.

WINDOWS 3.1

1. Start Windows.
2. Insert *Peeping Pete* into your CD ROM drive.
3. Within the Program Manager select the File menu option and then select Run.

In the Run window enter D:SETUP.EXE and Hit OK. If your CD Drive is not drive D, then replace the letter D with the correct letter of your CD Drive.

4. Return to the Program Manager and double click the *Peeping Pete* icon within the *Council* group.
