WELCOME TO SILLY GAMES!

INTRODUCTION

Hey kids! Are you ready for some fun? Ronald wants to invite you on an adventure full of surprises, jokes, laughs and tricks. Silly Games has five cool games to choose from: Jump 'n' Slide, Find-a-Treasure, Tic-Tac-Toe, Picture Dominoes, and Mix 'n' Match. Each game is a fun challenge.

MAIN SCREEN

When you enter the program, Ronald is right there to get you started! If you want to hear his introduction again, click on Ronald. If you want to pause the introduction, click anywhere on the screen. To hear the introduction again from the beginning, click on Ronald.

Sign In - The first thing you will be asked to do is sign in. Type in your name and click on DONE. Once you have signed in, you're ready to go! You won't be asked to sign in again, so



if you would like to sign in a friend, just click on the golden arches and the Sign In prompt will appear.

OPTIONS MENU

Click on the McDonaldland House to go to the Options Menu. From the Options Menu, you can change your audio, level of difficulty and hints options.



AUDIO

To turn the music On or Off, click on the musical notes. If they are highlighted, the music is on.

Click on the highlighted notes to turn the music off.

DIFFICULTY

Click on the top hamburger to make the games easy.

Click on the second row of two hamburgers for medium difficulty.

Click on the third row of three hamburgers for the ultimate challenge!

HINTS

Would you like to know which domino to play or which move to make next in Tic-Tac-Toe? Just click on the Fry Guy to highlight it. This turns on the Hints option. Want to try it on your own? Click on the highlighted Fry Guy to turn off the hint option.

NOTE: The Hints option applies to Picture Dominoes, Tic-Tac-Toe, and Jump 'n' Slide, but it does not apply to Find-a-Treasure. Because Find-a-Treasure is a game of chance, no hints are needed.

MAIN SCREEN MENU BAR

Click on the Happy Meal Box button in the lower right hand corner of the screen to view the Button bar. The Button bar consists of two options:

Help - Click on the Help button to hear a helpful hint.

Exit - Click on the Exit button to exit the program. Two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says YES to Exit the program. Click on the one that says NO to stay in the program.



GAMES MENU BAR

Once you've chosen a game, this same Happy Meal Box button will become the entry to the Games Menu Bar. Click on the Happy Meal Box button in the lower right hand corner of the screen to view the Button bar. The Button bar consists of two options: the Help button and the McDonaldland button.

Help - Click on the Help button for information on playing the game. A video of Ronald McDonald will tell you how to use help. Then click on the McNugget Buddies buttons to learn more about the game. Clicking on the McNugget Buddies Archer will tell you about the Objective of the game. Clicking on the McNugget Buddies Referee will tell you how to play the game. Last but not least, click on the McNugget Buddies Coach to get hints on game Strategy.

Help appears in video and text format. There is a MORE button that allows you to hear and read more about each subject. An AGAIN button that looks like a parrot, will repeat what you have just heard.

Click on the Exit button, located in the lower right hand corner of the screen, to return to the game you are playing.

McDonaldland button. Click on the McDonaldland button to exit the game you are playing and return to the



McDonaldland screen. Two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says YES to exit the game you are playing and return to the McDonaldland screen. Click on the one that says NO to stay in the program.

CERTIFICATE MENU BAR

When you win a game, a Congratulations Certificate appears on screen with your name on it. You can print this out by clicking on the Menu button in the lower right hand corner of the screen, and then clicking on the Print button. The print button looks like a smiling printer. You can also click on the Exit button to return to the Game.

GAME SELECTION

At the Main Screen, you can choose which game you want to play. To Select a Game:

Click on Hamburglar's House to play Jump 'n' Slide.



Click on Birdie's Tree House to play Picture Dominoes.



Click on the Happy Meal Hamburger and Fries' Tic-Tac-Toe grid to play Tic-Tac-Toe.



Click on the Fry Kids Forest to play Find-a-Treasure.



Click on the statue of Ronald McDonald next to Birdie's Tree House to Mix and Match.



Hint: If you are not sure where a game is located on the screen, move your mouse cursor over each area and Ronald will announce the name of each game.

TO BEGIN A GAME

Jump 'n' Slide, Find-a-Treasure, and Tic-Tac-Toe allow you to choose the character you want to be when you play the game.

In Jump 'n' Slide you can even choose your opponent.

First, click on the character you want to be. If you are playing Find-a-Treasure or Tic-Tac-Toe you will go directly to the game. If you choose Jump 'n' Slide, you will need to click on the character you want to play with before going to the game.

Here are the characters you can choose from for each game:

Jump 'n' Slide - Choose from Birdie, Grimace, and Hamburglar.

Find-a-Treasure - Choose between Fry Guy or Fry Girl.

Tic-Tac-Toe - Choose between the Happy Meal Hamburger or the Happy Meal Fries.

Picture Dominoes - There is no player selection for Picture Dominoes.

Mix and Match – There is no character selection for Mix and Match.

JUMP 'N' SLIDE

Objective

The object of the game is to be the first player to get to Hamburglar's house. The winner is the first player to land on the space in front of Hamburglar's door with an exact spin.

How to play Jump'n'Slide

1. Start your turn by clicking on the "radar wheel." When it stops spinning and lands on a number, you move that number of spaces forward.
2. You and your opponent will take turns spinning the "radar wheel" and moving the number of spaces it shows. There are many helping hands along the way and many pitfalls, so you are in for a few free rides, forwards or backwards — you never know 'til you get there!
3. When you get to Hamburglar's house, you need to land at his door with an exact spin. If

you spin over the amount needed, you will have to move the remaining spaces backwards, away from his door. For instance, if you are two spaces from his door and spin a four, you will move your character two steps forward and then two steps back. Don't worry. You'll get there eventually, unless someone else sneaks up from behind and gets there first.

4. When the game is over, two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says YES to play the game again. Click on the one that says NO to exit the game and return to the McDonaldland screen. If you are the big winner, a Congratulations Certificate appears. You can print it out and show all your friends that you are the champ.

Strategy

If you are trying to come up with a strategy for Jump 'n' Slide, forget it. It's all in the spin of the radar wheel!!!

The Jump 'n' Slide Screen

Radar Wheel - When it is your character's turn, click on the radar wheel to find out how many spaces to move.

Jump 'n' Slide Spaces - When it is your character's turn, click on the space that matches the number on the radar wheel.

Menu Bar - Click here to access Help or Exit.

Hotspots - These are hidden extras that are fun to click on.

1. Hamburglar House Door - Click on the door and it opens to show different characters standing in the doorway.
2. The Flag - Click on the flag and the colors and pictures on it change.
3. The Periscope - Click on the periscope and it goes in and out of its peephole.



Note: Click on the dotted square to move your character to a square that is covered by another character.

FIND-A-TREASURE

Objective

To win the Find-a-Treasure, you have to find all 5 of your opponent's treasures.

How to play

1. First, you must bury 5 treasures somewhere on the map. To do this, click on the Treasure that you want to bury. To bury the treasure, click on the square of the map where you want to bury it. Do this until all 5 of your treasures are buried.

2. Next, your opponent will hide his treasure. A tree covers the screen to hide this from your view. When the tree disappears, you can start hunting for treasure.

3. You must try to find your opponent's treasures and your opponent will try to find yours. Click on the square where you think your opponent's treasure is buried. If the square lights up (Yellow if you are Fry Girl and red if you are Fry Guy), you know you have found part of the treasure.

4. You and your opponent will take turns looking for the buried treasure. You'll need to keep digging until you find the whole treasure.

5. If the square that you picked turns black, that means there is no treasure there, so don't pick that square again.

6. The squares that contain the treasures remain identified by red or yellow squares as an unearthed treasure area. The first player to unearth all 5 of their opponent's treasures is the winner.

7. When the game is over, two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says YES to play the game again. Click on the one that says NO to exit the game and return to the McDonaldland screen. If you are the big winner, a Congratulations Certificate appears and you can print it out and show all your friends that you are the champ.



Strategy

Sorry, there's no strategy in this game. It's just the luck of the draw here, but here's a hint: once you find a part of the treasure, click around in the neighboring area to uncover the entire treasure.

The Find-a-Treasure Screen

Map – This is the area where the treasures are hidden.

Treasure Chest – This is where you will select your treasures in the beginning of the game. Click on the treasure you want to bury as it floats above the treasure chest. Click on the drawing map where you would like the treasure buried.

Menu Bar – Click here to access Help or Exit.

Hotspots - These are hidden extras that are fun to click on.

1. 2 Trees - When a user clicks on a tree, one of the trees tells a joke. Click again to hear another joke.

2. Volcano - Click on the volcano and it erupts.

3. Tree Snake - Click on the snake and it smiles.



TIC-TAC-TOE

Objective

The first player to get 3 of his pieces in a row is the winner.



How to Play

1. First, you must click on one of your players and then click on the square of the Tic-Tac-Toe board where you want it to go. For instance, if you have chosen to be the Happy Meal Hamburger, click on one of the hamburgers on the left side of the screen and then click on a square to place it. Note: The hamburgers and fries in the bleachers are just fans and Hamburglar and Fry Girl are the coaches. You can't choose any of them to make your move.
2. Each player takes turns placing a Happy Meal Hamburger or Happy Meal Fries in a square on the playing board.
3. The game is over when one player gets three in a row. When the game is over, two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says YES to play the game again. Click on the one that says NO to exit the game and return to the McDonaldland screen. If you are the big winner, a Congratulations Certificate appears and you can print it out and show all your friends that you are the champ.

Strategy

It sure helps if you can go first, but with a little thinking and planning ahead you can still win if you don't.

Note: The Happy Meal Hamburger always goes first.

Tic-Tac-Toe Screen

Tic-Tac-Toe Grid - This is where you will play. If you click anywhere on the grid with your cursor, the colors change.

Happy Meal Hamburger - Click on this and then click on the square where you want it to appear.

Happy Meal Fries - Click on this and then click on the square where you want it to appear.

Menu Bar - Click here to access Help or Exit.



Hotspots - These are hidden extras that are fun to click on.

1. Click on either one of the two flowers to hear a joke.

PICTURE DOMINOES

Objective: The object of the game is to use all of all your dominoes. The first player to get rid of all his dominoes wins.

How to play

1. Players first come to Birdie's Tree House. Click on the dominoes in the center of her table to begin.
2. Next, you'll come to a screen where all the dominos are laying face down on the table. Click on 14 of the 28 dominos to select the dominoes you want to play. Your opponent will take the rest.
3. First you will place a domino in the center. Each player then takes turns laying down matching dominoes. A domino can be connected to another if you can put matching pictures next to each other. For instance, place Hamburglar next to Hamburglar and Fries next to Fries. You do this by clicking on one of your dominoes and then clicking where you want to place it on the table.
4. If you do not have a matching domino to play, you will need to "pass" to the next player. To "pass" just click on the Pass button, which appears as a circle with a slash through it in the center of the screen.
5. The game is over when one player has used all of his pieces or if no player can play anymore dominoes. In that case, the winner is the player with the fewest dominoes.
6. When the game is over, two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says YES to play the game again. Click on the one that says NO to exit the game and return to the McDonaldland screen. If you are the big winner, a Congratulations Certificate appears and you can print it out and show all your friends that you are the champ.



Strategy

Here is a little clue that might help you win: when you play a domino, try to be sure that you have at least one of the pictures that you leave exposed, so if your opponent doesn't take the move you will have an opening for the next turn. Pay attention to the dominoes your opponent has to pass on. If you can play these dominoes, your opponent won't be able to go.

The Picture Dominoes Screen

Birdie's Table - This is where you will play the game. Click on your dominoes and then place them where you want them on the table.

The Picture Dominoes - Each domino has two pictures on it.

Menu Bar - Click here to access Help or Exit.

Hotspots - These are hidden extras that are fun to click on.

1. *Tablecloth* - Click on the tablecloth to change its pattern.
2. *Floor* - Click on the floor to change its pattern.
3. *Door* - Click on the door and it opens to a different McDonaldland area each time.
4. *Door Window* - Click on the window and a character's face appears.
5. *Window* - Click on the window and a character's face appears.



MIX 'N' MATCH

Objective

There are no rules here in Mix and Match. Anything goes! Mix and match the heads, bodies, and legs of Birdie, CosMc, Grimace, and Hamburglar. When you are done, you can print out your original creation.

How to play

1. Click on the heads, bodies and legs on the screen to create as many wacky combinations of the McDonaldland characters as you can imagine. You can also click on the background to change it.
2. When you have finished creating your mixed-up masterpiece, you can Print it out. Just, select the Happy Meal Box button in the lower right hand corner of the screen and choose the Print button from the Button bar. Now you can return to the game and mix and match again or click on the McDonaldland button to return to the Main Screen.


McDONALDLAND SCREEN SAVER!

Included with this program is a free McDonaldLand Screen Saver! Kids can have a giggle watching their favorite McDonaldLand characters bouncing around the computer screen, stretching and jiggling.

To install the McDonaldLand Screen Saver, double-click on the McDonaldLand Screen Saver Installer icon included in the McDonaldLand Program Folder, which should appear on your desktop following installation. This will begin the Screen Saver install process described below in steps 4-8. You can always install the program later from the Windows 95 Taskbar.

WINDOWS 95

To Install the McDonaldLand Screen Saver from the Windows 95 Taskbar:




1. Make sure your McDonaldLand CD is inserted in your CD-ROM drive!
2. Click on the Start button on the Taskbar.

3. Choose Programs, McDonaldLand, then click on the McDonaldLand Screen Saver Installer icon. This will begin the Screen Saver installation process.
4. A dialog box will ask you to wait while the McDonaldLand Screen Saver Setup prepares the InstallShield® Wizard to guide you through the rest of the setup process.
5. Next, the McDonaldLand Screen Saver Setup screen will appear. It is recommended that you exit all Windows programs before running Setup. You can choose Cancel to quit Setup and close any programs you have running. Click on Next to continue with the Setup program.
6. The License Agreement screen will appear next. Click on Yes to agree to the terms and continue with the Setup program.
7. The Choose Destination Location screen appears next. Click on Next to install McDonaldLand Screen Saver to the default directory (or choose Browse and select another destination, then choose Next to continue).
8. The Screen Saver Setup Complete screen will appear next. Select Finish to complete the Screen Saver installation.

Using McDonaldLand Screen Saver

You are now ready to run the McDonaldLand Screen Saver. To run the Screen Saver and adjust the display properties:

1. Click on the Start button on the Windows Taskbar.
2. Choose Settings, then Control Panel.
3. Double-click on the Display icon.
4. The Display Properties window will appear. Select the Screen Saver tab.
5. Click on the Screen Saver drop down menu and select **McDland**. You will see a mini preview in the display window.



6. You can set the amount of time that will elapse before windows displays the Screen Saver, in the **Wait for (1) minutes** section.
7. Select the Settings button to adjust the Screen Saver speed, change sound effects or turn the sound On or Off. See the section below for screen Screen Saver options.
8. Click on **Apply** to apply your settings. Click on **OK** to return to the desktop.

Screen Saver Settings Dialog Box

This enables you to customize the McDonaldLand Screen Saver settings. You can change the following options:



1. Sound Effects

There are thirteen sound effects to choose from. Select the one that you want to apply to the Screen Saver and click the OK button to have that sound applied to the Screen Saver. You can also choose Random, which enables the computer to cycle through all sound effects providing variety.

2. Speed

You can choose the speed in which the McDonaldLand characters bounce around your monitor. There are three settings; slow, moderate and fast. Once you have selected the speed click the OK button to apply that speed to the Screen Saver.

3. Sound Effects On or Off

This enables you to have sounds turned On or Off. This setting will not affect any other Screen Saver settings. Once you have made your selection click on the OK button to apply your choice.

To cancel your changes, select the Cancel button and your original settings will be restored.

4. About Button

Provides you with information about the Screen Saver.

Activating the McDonaldLand Screen Saver

McDonaldLand Screen Saver will automatically activate after the time set in the Wait field in the Screen Saver area of the Display Properties dialog box. You can also manually activate the Screen Saver by using the icon in the McDonaldLand program folder.

To manually activate the Screen Saver:

1. Click on the Start button on the Windows Taskbar.

2. Choose Programs, then McDonaldLand.

3. Click on the McDonaldLand Screen Saver icon. This will activate the Screen Saver Program.

Your desktop will be restored when you click on a key or move the mouse.

Note: the Windows 95 Password Protection option has been disabled for this program therefore Windows will not ask for a password when the Screen Saver is active.

Uninstalling McDonaldLand Screen Saver:

To uninstall the McDonaldLand Screen Saver:

1. Click on the Start button on the Windows Taskbar.
2. Click on Settings.
3. Click on Control Panel.
4. Double-click on Add/Remove Programs.
5. The Add/Remove Programs Properties window will appear. Make sure the Install/Uninstall tab is selected.
6. Select McDonaldLand Screen Saver from the scroll down menu.
7. Click on the Add/Remove button.
8. A Confirm File Deletion dialog box will appear. Select Yes to continue.
9. The UninstallShield will appear and will remove the associated files from your system.

You will see the Uninstall successfully completed message when the process has been completed.
