1.3 Installing F1 Manager on your harddisk

Harddisk installation

This version of F1 Manager requires a harddisk. To install it on your harddisk just boot from your harddisk, then insert the F1 manager program disk in the drive. Double click on the disk icon and then double click on the 'F1-Install' icon. The installation utility will then load. Before installation will start you will need to select the installation mode. If you do not know very much about the computer select 'Novice' and then click on the 'Proceed' button. The installation will then be fully automatic. You need 1 MB of free space on your harddisk to install F1 Manager.

1.6 Tips & Tricks

Tips & Tricks

Write down all the setups you use for the qualifying sessions and the race. This way when you race on that track again you roughly have an idea what setup to use.

Start giving money for the development of a chassis right at the start of the season. If you wait with giving money till the end of the season you will have a very bad chassis next season.

Calculate exactly how much fuel you are going to put in your car during the race. If you put too much in, the car is heavier and subsequently will go much slower. ALWAYS put some extra fuel in your car, because the fuel consumption is just an estimate.

Always make a pitstop if your tyre meter is very low, if you don't your driver has a very high chance to spin or crash and be out of the race.

If during the race it starts to rain do not make a pitstop right away but wait a while until it gets a bit wet. If the track is approximately 20% wet it is best to make a pitstop and switch to wet tyres (W).

If you have warm weather select A or B compound tyres. C and D compound tyres lose their grip very quick forcing you to make an early pitstop

1.7 Known bugs of F1 Manager

Known bugs:

On some Amiga 1200's with fast memory the sounds during the race sound weird. I am not sure how this happens, but you can fix it by using the 'NoFastmem' program supplied on your workbench disk in the 'system' drawer.
