

Welcome to WinTuner!

WinTuner is a tuner program especially for guitarists, but it suits the needs of a lot of other instruments. It helps you tune quickly and easily even with non-standard tunings, and non 440Hz "A" frequencies. It also includes the unique Calibrating function, which allows exact tuning even with soundcards with not too precise sampling frequencies.

WinTuner vs pocket tuners

Even though you cannot take easily a PC to the stage (except when your synth-man uses a sequencer) , WinTuner can help you tune up your instrument while / before practising. It also provides features not every (or none of the) pocket tuners do: full chromatic tuning, adjustable "A" frequency, reference tones and a user-expandable tuning library. The other advantage on the side of WinTuner is the price: \$20. You won't get a pocket tuner for this price!

System requirements

In order to run WinTuner you need a Windows 3.1, and a computer which is able to run Windows 3.1. If you want to get reference tones, you will also need a MIDI driver on your system, as well as a MIDI synth. (Reference tones use MIDI out). If you want to get the most out of WinTuner, you will also need a soundcard able to digitize from a MIC-IN and/or a LINE-IN port. In addition, you will need cables/microphone to connect your instrument into this port.

Installation

You don't need to do much to install WinTuner: Just unpack **wintuner.zip** to any directory. Add an icon for WinTuner to your favorite Program Manager group. You may want to move the *.DLL files to your Windows directory, so other programs may use them as well.
