

Thank you for using QuickRun, a program that lets you find and run your most favorite programs faster and easier.

Getting Started

To Add a Menu to QuickRun, click with the right mouse button on the QuickRun bar and select **Customize**. Next, click on the **Menus** tab and then click **New...** Now enter the name for the menu and click OK.

To Add a Program to QuickRun, click with the right mouse button on a QuickRun menu and click **Add Program**. Enter the path and name of the program in the Program Location box, or click **Browse**, then click **Next**. Enter the name you would like to have displayed on the menu and click **Next**. Select the icon for the program and click Finish.

You can also add programs to a QuickRun menu by dragging it to the icon for that menu.

For additional help on using QuickRun, click the right mouse button on the QuickRun bar and click **Help**. You can also get help in all dialog boxes in QuickRun by clicking the question mark in the upper right corner of the title bar and then clicking on a item to learn how to use it.

What's New to Version 3.0

- Icons from the System Tray (area beside the clock on the taskbar) can be moved to menu on the QuickRun bar to reduce clutter on the taskbar.
- The Desktop, Control Panel, and any folder can be added to QuickRun as a menu.
- Option to sort the programs on a menu automatically.
- The selected menu item background can be changed to a gradient fill.
- The text font and color can now be changed for the menu sidebar.
- The order the menus can now be changed by holding down the **ALT** key and dragging a menu icon to the desired location.
- When the QuickRun bar is docked on the taskbar, it can now be resized by dragging the size grip.
- Hover mode now works differently: When you move the mouse off of a menu without running something, it will disappear. The amount of time before the menu is shown can now be changed.
