Overview

Palette is a Control Panel applet allowing the user to change the hardware palette of a 16 color or greater VGA adapter. 256 color registers are available regardless of the actual Windows palette in use. Remember, if you're not careful, you'll end up possibly rebooting your machine if you set the colors so you can't read the text anymore!

Colors

Colors may be set by selecting a palette entry in the "**Palette Offset**" list and moving the scrollbars or entering a number from 0 to 63 in an edit box pertaining to color to change. All changes are made immediately to the hardware palette by the scrollbars and by leaving an edit box to any other control, including another edit box.

Save

A palette may be saved by pressing the "**Save**" button. You are prompted for a filename and, if another file using that name exists, whether to overwrite the file found. The default extension used by the program is "**CPA**"

Load

Palettes may be loaded from disk, assuming at least one palette has been saved. Press the "**Load**" button to display a window prompting you for a filename. Select a file and press OK or Cancel to exit without loading a palette. If loaded, the palette is read and put into action.
