

Becoming a Registered User

We thank you for giving CD Master a test drive. Registration is easy and it ensures that we at Simplicity Computers can continue to develop low cost, quality applications for Windows. When you register, you will be sent a registration number that will stop the annoying "Unregistered Software" message.

What should I register for?

Option one is the cheapest. It registers the version of CD Master which you currently have. It costs \$11.00.

Option two is the middle option. It registers the version of CD Master which you currently have and gets you the current version, (or the next upgrade, if you have the current version), mailed to you on a 1.44M floppy. It costs \$14.95.

Option three is the most expensive. It registers the current version and places you on our subscription service. This will allow you to receive at least 4 version upgrades, or a full years worth of upgrades, whichever comes LAST. It cost \$25.95.

If you live outside the United States and are registering for Option two or three, you must include an extra \$4 to cover additional postage, customs fees and handling.

NOTE: People who register via the BBS such as Compuserve are registered for Option 1.

You may upgrade to a higher option at any time by paying the then current price difference.

Individual copies of the unregistered version of CD Master may be given to friends and associates for the same thirty day free trial period. You may also upload CD Master to the public section of a public BBS.

You may not modify or disassemble CD Master, nor distribute any modified or disassembled versions of CD Master. CD Master may not be included with any other product without written permission from Simplicity Computers.

Registration of CD Master (the "SOFTWARE") permits you to use the "SOFTWARE" on a single computer. The "SOFTWARE" is in "use" on a computer when it is loaded into temporary memory (i.e., RAM) or installed into permanent memory (e.g., hard disk, CD-ROM, or other storage device) of that computer.
