What It Is

This program consists of a single, small (17k) executable. No other support files are needed. I wrote this program as an easy way to randomize wallpaper, sound, cursors or anything else at startup. Simply call this program from your AUTOEXEC.BAT as described below.

How to Use It

You must provide two parameters. Parameter one is the filespec used to randomly pick the file, Parameter two is the destination path.

Ex: rdomize c:\windows*.bmp c:\windows\wallpaper.bmp

This will choose a random file matching c:\windows*.bmp and copy the file to c:\windows\wallpaper.bmp. If there is an existing wallpaper.bmp, it'll be overwritten without warning. Long file names are supported for destination filenames, but not for the filespec (this usually shouldn't cause a problem).
