NOTICE TO USERS OF INTERNET EXPLORER FROM MICROSOFT:

If you are using a Beta version of IE 3.0 then you need to upgrade to the final version of 3.0. If you don't, the slider for the AutoSave feature will be invisible.

NOTICE TO USERS GETTING THE ERROR MESSAGE "Not licensed for this functionality" OR A RELATED ERROR:

If you are getting this error, then you have a "broken" version of a file called TABCTL32.OCX. A fixed version of this file is available from the MainTree Systems web site

Version 1.2:

- Added the ability to change the font & colors In each note separately
- Added a Action menu with the following features:
 - Added the ability to save notes out to text files
 - Added the ability to read notes from text files (4k Limit)
 - Added basic note printing
 - Added "Delete Note" option inside the note (The most requested feature in this version)
- Removed the "Reset Options" button (No one used it! Not even me!)
- Added "Reset Notes" button to fixed any font flubs made by new feature #1 up there.
- Added "Show All Notes" to the system tray menu.

- General cosmetic fix-ups to conform to Windows95 interface design standards
- Fixed a error when trying to Default size a Maximized note. (I would have just prevented the maximization, but some people liked it.)
