These tutorials have hopefully given you enough of an overview of the program to get started. Before starting your first drawing, you may want to go through the examples. The examples give a step by step demonstration on how to create a drawing. The examples are located on the *Help/Examples* menu.

The *Help/About* command displays the current version number and copyright for this program. The *Help/Using help* command brings up a help file which describes how to use the Windows help facility.

All of the other commands on the *Help* menu use the main GammaCAD help file and give additional information on GammaCAD commands and procedures. When a command is active, you can go straight to the section which describes that command by choosing *Help/On current command* from the menu or by clicking on this button on the command tool bar. The *Keyword search* command allows you to search for a topic based on a keyword. It is similar to an index in a printed manual.
