- Minimize:** Use this selection to **Minimize Internet Organizer** to the Taskbar.
- Configure: Select the File Location for each button and other program Options for **Internet Organizer**.
- Exit:** To leave or shutdown **Internet Organizer**.

File Location

Click on the OPEN FOLDER icon to the right of each button designation. This will open the dialog box to select your executable file (*.exe) for that button. Click on OPEN to select the file. If there are Command Line Parameters for the program you are setting up, enter them into the Parameters dialog box and click on OK. If not, click on CANCEL. The executable file will appear in the appropriate File Location window. Click on **APPLY** to save changes and remain in the File Location screen, **CANCEL** to leave this screen without saving any changes, or **OK** to save changes and exit the **Internet Organizer** Configuration screen.

<u>Options</u>	These Options allow you to set the physical features of the program.
Skip Start-Up Screen	Bypasses the startup screen.
Minimize on Start-Up	Sets Internet Organizer to "minimized" when the program is started.
Always Visible	Sets the main window to be on top of all other programs that are running.
<u>Layout</u>	Sets the look of the Internet Organizer main window.
Horizontal Bar	Creates a horizontal bar on the screen.
Rectangle	Creates a rectangular box on the screen.
Vertical Bar	Creates a vertical bar on the screen.
Setting Up Winsock	This setting will be activated when the CONNECT button is depressed. A Find File dialog box will appear to locate the Winsock PROGRAM that is used to start your Internet session when the Winsock button is clicked.
Button Names	This feature allows you to change any of the names on the buttons in the main window.

What is Shareware?

Shareware distribution gives users a chance to try software before buying it. If you try a Shareware program and continue using it, you are expected to register. Individual programs differ on details -- some request registration while others require it, some specify a maximum trial period. With registration, you get anything from the simple right to continue using the software to an updated program with printed manual.

Copyright laws apply to both Shareware and commercial software, and the copyright holder retains all rights, with a few specific exceptions as stated below. Shareware authors are accomplished programmers, just like commercial authors, and the programs are of comparable quality. (In both cases, there are good programs and bad ones!) The main difference is in the method of distribution. The author specifically grants the right to copy and distribute the software, either to all and sundry or to a specific group. For example, some authors require written permission before a commercial disk vendor may copy their Shareware.

Shareware is a distribution method, not a type of software. You should find software that suits your needs and pocketbook, whether it's commercial or Shareware. The Shareware system makes fitting your needs easier, because you can try before you buy. And because the overhead is low, prices are low also. Shareware has the ultimate money-back guarantee -- if you don't use the product, you don't pay for it.
