This program was designed to synchronize files between two directories on the same machine, or two directories between two machines connected through a network or dial-up-networking. It can also be used as a "briefcase" and transport the data between two unconnected machines.

On the first run, you will need to select your data folders. These are the folders that hold the data locally (home) and the folder on some removable media or another networked machine (briefcase). This is done by selecting the **FILE LISTS** tab and double-clicking on either the *Home Folder Path* or *Briefcase Folder Path* entry blanks. This will bring up the **EDIT PATH DIALOG**. Simply select your two paths on this screen and select **SAVE**.

After the initial run, it will automatically evaluate both directories and add the changed or missing files to the correct file lists.

The files are now ready for evaluation.

Select a Window Panel and right click for a Pop-up-menu.

Note: ~dt-sync.dat found in the home or briefcase directory contains the date and time stamp of when the synchronizer was last run on that file set.

Items listed in the Home Folder list will be updated by the newer version contained in the Briefcase list.

Items listed in the Briefcase list will be updated by the new version contained in the Home Folder list.

Update Window Pop-Up-Menu

Swap Files: Switch copy mode (from Home to Briefcase, Briefcase to Home);

Delete Files: Move respective file to respective delete window.

Remove Files: Remove respective file from list.

Items listed in the Home Folder list will be added to the Home Folder.
Items listed in the Briefcase list will be added to the Briefcase.

Use the [Pop-up-menu](#) to manipulate files.

Add Window Pop-Up-Menu

Delete Files: Move respective file to opposite delete window. (if file exists in Briefcase and not in Home, the file will show up in the Home window. Deleteing this file will delete it from the Briefcase and Visa-Versa.)

Remove Files: Remove respective file from list.

Delete Files Panel

Items listed in the Home Folder list will be deleted from the home folder.
Items listed in the Briefcase list will be deleted from the briefcase.

Use the [Pop-up-menu](#) to manipulate files.
