
The first number shows the total number of active connections, the second shows the maximum connections for which the server is licensed.



History of Changes

Version 0.97 25 November 1996

Version 0.97 is the final release before version 1.00, the following changes have been made:

- Corrected memory allocation problem in the hierarchy window that occurred if there are more than 7500 users defined.
- Simplified installation of registration key.
- Further additions to the help file.

Version 0.96 24 October 1996

The following changes have been incorporated in this release:

- Added a connections in use window.
- Option to save window positions and sizes.
- Double click on user/group in hierarchy now opens the maintenance window for the clicked object.
- User creation dialog now allows a password to be specified.
- Deleting a user will now remove the user's mailbox and all its subdirectories, if requested.
- Various bug fixes.

Version 0.95 03 September 1996

Version 0.95 is primarily a bug fix release, but it also includes the following new features:

- Volume Restrictions for Users.
- Intruder Detection control from Supervisor Options
- Printing option for System Login Script, Server Autoexec and Server Error Log.

Version 0.90 22 July 1996

Version 0.90 contains some minor bug fixes plus the following new features:

- Support for Workgroup Managers.
- Option to display users and groups simultaneously in the hierarchy window.
- Home directory now created when a user is created.
- File server information refreshed every 30 seconds.
- Supervisor options implemented.

Version 0.85 30 June 1996

Version 0.85 contained new features plus some minor bug fixes, as follows:

New Features:

Intruder lockout information on the User tabs.
Attach to File Server now available in the hierarchy box server menu.
User defined font for the edit windows.
About dialog now shows version number and registration status.
Right click in the hierarchy box now changes selection before showing popup menu.
Help file started.
Inserting/Renaming and Deleting users/groups will now update all open windows.
User and Group maintenance dialogs are now multi-select (for Delete only).

Bugs Fixed:

Rename button in the User/Group selection dialog not disabled if the caller is not a supervisor equivalent.
Failure to open user login script results in a blank tab being displayed.
Building a user/groups trustees can take an excessive length of time.
File Server Information doesn't clear listbox, if failure connecting.
Menu titles: Edit, Server & Maintenance, do not have status bar help.
Hierarchy box occasionally loses item that has focus when destroying nodes
Hierarchy box loses track of +/- bitmaps when scrolling.
User viewing allowed Trustees, Security Equivalents and Login Script when the caller does not have the required privilege.
Cut/Delete/Paste menu items remained enabled when viewing the error log.
If not supervisor equivalent, the system login script and autoexec should only be available in view mode.
Many problems with the hierarchy box, related to scrolling.

Version 0.80 16 June 1996

This was the first public release.

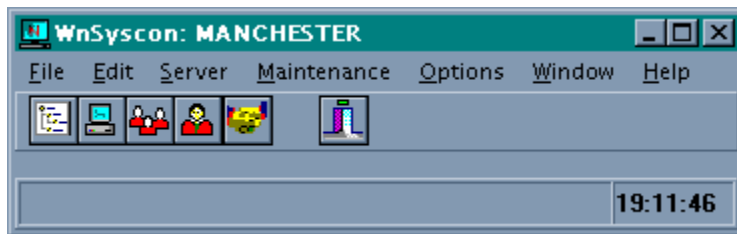
Introduction

WnSyscon is a shareware Netware 2.x, 3.x administration utility that runs under Microsoft Windows version 3.1, 3.11 and 95.

It enables the Netware administrator to modify/create Users and Groups, edit login scripts (User and System), and edit the Netware Autoexec files. Most of the functionality of Novell's DOS based Syscon program is provided, but with the added advantages that a Windows environment provides.

Many enhancements are planned for the future, see Future Developments. for more information.

WnSyscon's main window consists of a title bar, speed buttons and a status bar. Move the mouse over the picture, when the cursor becomes a hand, click the mouse for further help.

Shareware

Shareware distribution gives users a chance to try software before buying it. If you try a Shareware program and continue using it, you are expected to register. 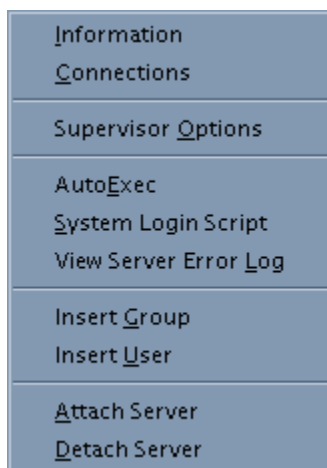
The following bitmaps are used to represent the different network objects:

Server, User and Group objects have an associated popup menu that is activated by clicking on the object with the right-mouse-button.

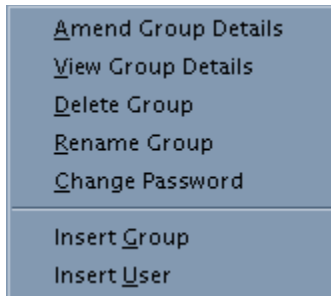
Server Menu.

This is the associated menu for a file server object.



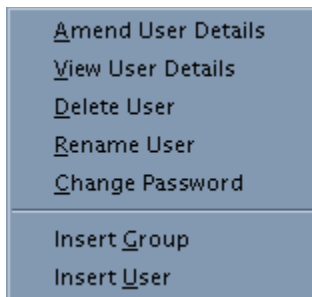
Group Menu

This is the associated menu for a user object.

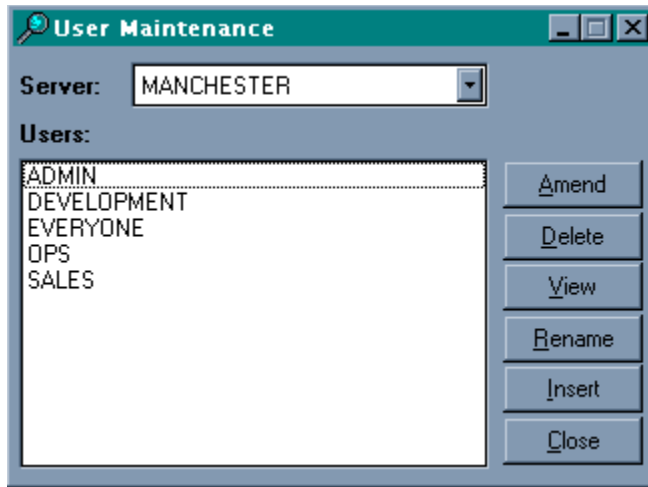


System Hierarchy
