# **Copy Button**

The Copy button copies the contents of the adjacent Quick-Clip into the clipboard so that it may be pasted into any application that supports the clipboard 'Paste' function.

#### **Advanced**

The 'Advanced' button will enlarge the window to show another Quick-Clip slot and a list of saved Quick-Clips. To save the current contents to the Advanced slot click 'Save Here', this will not save the contents, to save the contents you must hit the 'Save As' button.

To view the contents of pass saved Quick-Clips, click on a name in the window shown. To remove a Long Term Quick Clip, right click the name and hit Remove.
