INTRODUCTION

I created Pro Start because I needed a way to start up several applications upon startup of Windows 95. I need those applications to startup in a certain order and not necessarily alphebetical order. This is my first C++ program, so there might be a few bugs.

INSTALLATION

This program requires the use of an INI file. The name of this file is PROSTRT.INI and should be located in the WINDOWS Directory. The INI file is used to store the names of the files to be started and in what order they will be started. You would also place the amount of time, in seconds, you want to wait before the Applications begin to Start. The file looks like this:

[Startup]

1=filename	The <i>filename</i> is the complete directory
2 =filename	path and filename of the Application.
3= filename	Files will be started in Numerical Order.
etc	

[Timer] Seconds=seconds

The <u>seconds</u> is the amount of time, in seconds, you would like to wait, after **Pro Start** has started, for your Applications to begin to start.

That is all there is to this file.

HOW TO USE

Place the EXE file in your startup folder. When Windows starts up so will the program. Your applications will begin starting, in the order you specify, once the time specified in the PROSTRT.INI file has expired.
