Introduction

Thank you for choosing to evaluate DIZ Assistant Version 1.02

DIZ Assistant scans and extracts (when present) a file named FILE_ID.DIZ from a compressed file and inserts the relevant data into the Downman database fields for you.

This Assistant is provided **free** to registered users of Downman and requires Downman version 1.1 or above !!

What is an Assistant ?

To assist you in entering the data into the Downman record fields there is a programmable, plug-in interface designed into Downman.

Whenever you download a file, there usually exists a brief description of the file, whether on-line or off-line or stored within the file itself. An assistant will help you get that data into the database, so you may search through descriptions, keywords etc. at a later date.

Plug In Assistants Available.

*** CompuServe Navigator Assist**

Scans the session file and off-line library and extracts the data into the fields for you. This Assistant is provided **free** to registered users of Downman !!

*** Library Assist**

Scans one of those CompuServe forum library summaries that can be downloaded and extracts the relevant data.

This Assistant is provided **free** to registered users of Downman !!

*** CompuServe WinCim Assist**

Extracts the file abstracts, title etc. from WinCim, in preparation for insertion into the Downman storage interface.

This Assistant is provided **free** to registered users of Downman !!

***DIZ Assist**

Opens a compressed file and scans for the DIZ file description, extracting the data and placing it in the Downman database.

Works with PKUNZIP.EXE, ARJ.EXE and LHA.EXE.

This Assistant is provided **free** to registered users of Downman !!

Installation

DIZASS32.ZIP

This file contains the following files:

README.WRI - This file

DIZASS32.DLL - The plugin assistant.

DIZASS.DMA - Installation file used by Downman to setup this assistant.(See Below)

To add any new assistant to Downman, unzip the assistant in a temporary directory. Select Preferences| Assistants|Install from the main Downman menu, and use the dialog to select the *.DMA file in the temporary directory.

Downman will then automatically install the new assistant for you.

You should then select Preferences|Assistants|Configure to setup any defaults required. In this case you will have to tell DIZ Assistant where it can find the following files on your system:

PKUNZIP.EXE

LHA.EXE

ARJ.EXE

You may be able to get away with just having PKUNZIP.EXE as the ZIP file seems to be the most common form of file compression used today.

If you donot already have these files, you will find them in the PC Communications forum on Compuserve. (GO PCCOMM).

Important Note

At present, Diz Assist works only with the files listed above, but should work with WinZip32 by the next release. Because PKUNZIP is a 16 Bit application, it will not work with Windows 95 Long File Names. Therefore, if you find Diz Assist is not extracting FILE_ID.DIZ files from Zipped files you should see if your Downman Subdirectory conforms to 8.3 file name specifications (Try using DOWNMN32 for your sub directory name).

DIZ Assistant Limitations

DIZ Assistant extracts data from the file FILE_ID.DIZ, usually enclosed in a lot of compressed files avaiable from Compuserve, The Internet and Bulliten Boards.

The format of this file is supposed to be standard, however, alot of software authors pay no attention to the required format and use their own method of laying out a diz file.

Therefore, DIZ Assistant will attempt to extract the data in the best way possible, but it is impossible to anticipate how an author may use this file. Sometimes you may have to do a little cut and pasting.

If you are a registered user of Downman, you will receive notification by E-Mail, when a new assistant or an upgrade of an assistant becomes available.
