### Introduction

**Password, Inc.** is a program which you can use to store a list of passwords. It can be valuable for anyone using the Internet or an on-line service as you can store various login names and passwords for dial up connections and to access your e-mail accounts.

### How To...

#### To add a new password to your list:

From the Password menu, select New, or click on the New Password icon on the toolbar.

#### To remove a password from the list:

From the Password menu, select Delete, or click on the Delete Password icon on the toolbar.

#### To modify a password or change your user settings:

From the Password menu, select Edit, or click on the Edit Password icon on the toolbar.

#### To configure the program settings to suit your needs:

From the Password menu, select Preferences, or click on the Preferences icon on the toolbar.

#### To exit from Password, Inc. and return to Windows:

From the Password menu, select Close, or click on the Close icon on the toolbar.
