

Introduction

KeyClick provides an audible click when keyboard keys are pressed. KeyClick uses the built-in PC speaker and does NOT require a sound card.

Required Hardware and Software

'386, '486, or Pentium computer running Windows 4.0 or Windows NT.

Installing the Program

In the DOS shell, or with the Windows File Manager, create a subdirectory for the program. For example:

```
MKDIR C:\KEYCLICK
```

Then copy all files from the distribution disk into the subdirectory. For example:

```
COPY A:\*.* C:\KEYCLICK
```

The program is made up of the following files: `KEYCLICK.EXE` and `KC_DLL.DLL`.

Go to the Program Manager and open up the Startup Group. Then select the File menu and the New submenu. Press the Program Item button and the OK button. Enter `KeyClick` in the Description field, and enter the location of the program in the Command Line field, for example:

```
C:\KEYCLICK\KEYCLICK.EXE
```

Press the OK button.

KeyClick is now installed.

Running KeyClick

When installed in your Startup group, KeyClick will be run automatically every time you start Windows 4.0 or Windows NT.
